Amazon Water Control Funds Sought by Ike

President Eisenhower asked Congress Monday for \$100,000 in appropriations for the Amazon Water Control district. This money is to be used for construction of a concrete line channel to run from the eastern boundary of the fair grounds to 18th street. Army engineers estimated \$277,000 would be needed for completion of the project. If Congress does appropriate the \$100,000, according to Kenneth Nielsen, Lane county commissioner, the project would not be started until July 1. Actual construction probably would not begin until the following summer.

Residents west of Eugene became interested in such a project as early as 1941, but nothing on a cooperative basis has been done until recently. As it stands, the city will buy the new channel, the federal government will do the actual construction, army engineers will survey the area, and the county will build bridges to connect with the county roads over the channel.

The area has already been surveyed by army engineers several times. If the full \$100,000 appropriation is passed, another survey will be conducted early in July, followed by bidding for the construction contract.

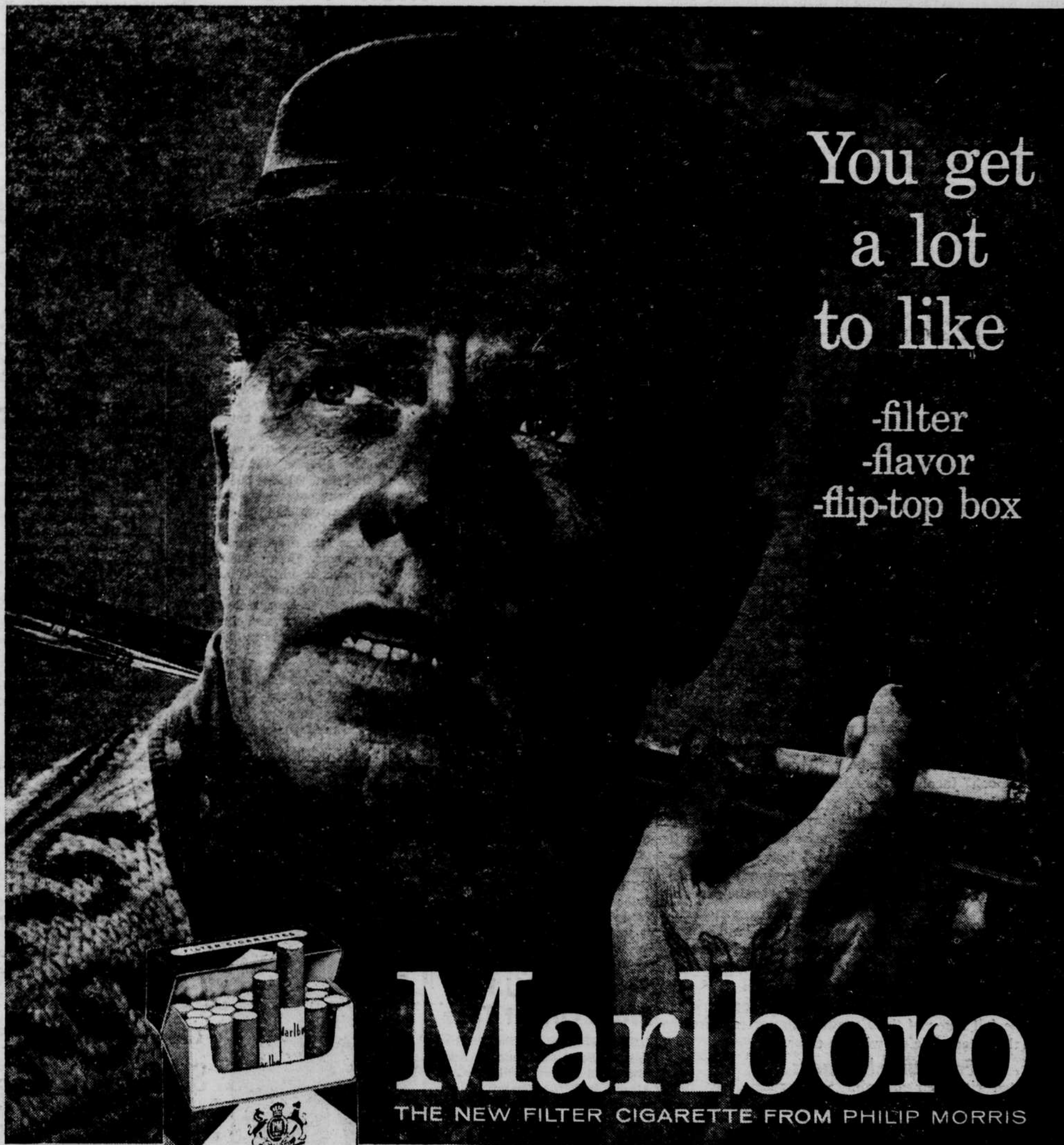
The construction will begin at the east end and will continue

west as far as the money will allow.

The concrete line channel will be a big improvement over the present conditions. This type of channel will carry more than twice the amount of water now running through the present channel.

According to Congressional procedure, the \$100,000 appropriation money will be included in the River and Harbor Bill which should come up for debate in Congress in May or June.

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
