If the skin has enlarged pores or blackheads and pimples then it would be better to use a compact or powder rouge as this will be used last of all, over the powder and the lotion, so as to avoid working the rouge into the skin. Compact rouge cannot be applied directly on the skin as it will not go on smoothly: A creamy or oily powderbase is wrong on a complexion with blackheads and pimples-this skin needs a lotion with a waterbase.

If you want to alter the shape of the mouth then be sure to use a tinted powderbase all over your face and after cleansing the lips of every scrap of old lipstick bring the base well over the edge of the lips. Always use your lip-
