Puddles to Remind Owners Of Telephone Dial Changes

Reminding everyone that all Eugene and Springfield phone numbers will change Saturday, March 17 at 11 p.m., will be "Puddles," the University of Oregon duck, according to Thaxter Reed, Pacific Telephone manager.

The University and Walt Disney, creator of Puddles' prototype, "Donald," gave Puddles permission to sign up with the telephone company to help publicize the number change.

Puddles will appear in newspaper ads and instruction pamph-

lets and on booth cards, telephone trucks and window posters, Reed said.

The change will add prefixes to present telephone numbers so that each number will consist of seven digits. Prefixes are Diamond 3, 4 or 5, for Eugene, and Riverside 6 or 7 for Springfield.

Calls will not go through after the change is made unless the dial is "pulled" the full seven times by dialing the two letters and numerals of the prefix and then the four other numerals of the number wanted.



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
