De Paur Group Here Thursday

Thursday night at 8 the Eugene University Civic Music Association will present the De Paur Opera Gala, a mixed chorus featuring thirty singers and twenty-five musicians.

The concert will be a presentation of excerpts from three operas. Selections from "Carmen Jones," Oscar Hammerstein's English adaptation of Bizet's opera, "Four Saints in Three Acts," by Gertrude Stein and Virgil Thomson, and Gershwin's "Porgy and Bess," will form the evening's repertoire.

The feminine lead in the original "Carmen Jones," Inez Matthews, has the lead in the De Paur presentation. Lawrence Winters, guest star of the Hamburg State Opera, the Royal Opera of Stockholm will also appear. He is baritone with the New York Opera Company.

Luther Saxon, tenor with the "Carmen Jones" production and soloist with the old De Paur Infantry chorus, will also perform.

Leonard De Paur and William Jackson will direct the Opera Gala.
