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Porter Criticizes Aid to Dictators

Foreign aid to nations governed by dictatorship is not consistent with belief in democratic ideals, Congressman Charles O. Porter said in a Thursday coffee hour discussion on moral foreign policy.

Concentrating on criticism of U.S. aid to the Dominican Republic, Nicaragua, and Venezuela, Oregon's Fourth Congressional District Representative condemned the policy of letting police state countries identify with the U. S. He advocated cutting off aid to the Dominican Republic and criticized the president, Trujillo, saying that present aid only gives a "cloak of respectability" to dictatorship.

Only Justification

"The only justification of foreign aid is defense of Americans," Porter said. "Humanitarian principles don't give us the right to spend taxpayer's money. We don't have a social mission to help the poor. Foreign aid is moral only in terms of the welfare of the American people."

Porter voiced his disagreement with a moral foreign policy that

makes decisions in terms of power rather than the character of governments aided. "It is not necessary to break relationships with dictatorships," he said, "but when we support them, our country gives misleading impressions to democratic nations."

Filed Bill

Porter, who has filed the only bill in Congress to stop all nuclear tests, also said that the U.S. should offer to cease the tests if other countries will.

"Research has already done the job to end human life," he said. "Why try to make bigger bombs that will reach their destinations faster?"

Limited warfare has not worked practically in the past, he said, and we cannot expect a future war to be limited in any way.
