

2 Webfoots Named to All-Coast

Shanley, Mondale Picked For Spots on INS Team

National oddsmakers rated Oregon and Oregon State, battling this Saturday for the Pacific Coast Conference crown, even money as their homecoming "Civil War" Saturday contest draws near.

Another noteworthy event took place Wednesday. International News Service named two Webfoots, halfback Jim Shanley and guard Harry Mondale, and two Beavers, fullback Nub Beamer and center Buzz Randall, on their all-coast first team.

INS also named fullback Jack Morris and center Norm Chapman from Oregon and halfback Joe Francis from OSC on its second team.

Len Casanova's Ducks had short workouts Wednesday as the crucial battle approaches, and probably the healthiest team since the season began will go into Saturday's contest. Only tackle Jerry Kershner is on the doubtful list with pulled muscles, but chances are he'll be ready by the 1:30 kickoff time.

Coach Tommy Prothro and his Beaver squad have been working

under locked gates and the Aggie coach isn't even saying who's on his injured list.

OSC Win Means Tie

A victory for the Webfoots Saturday would clinch their first undisputed PCC title, but the Beavers will be out to win. Sporting a 5-2 record OSC can share the 1957 crown with the Ducks with a triumph.

Most of the 24,500 seats in Hayward Field had been sold by Wednesday with only a few \$5.00 end zone seats remaining.

Prothro and eight graduating seniors on the Oregon State squad will be looking for their first victory over the Ducks since arriving at the school. The Ducks won in 1954, '33-14; again in 1955, 28-0; and tied the Rose Bowl bound Beavers last year, 14-14.

The Ducks clinched the unofficial Rose Bowl berth last Saturday with a 16-7 victory over Southern California in Los Angeles and in doing so, became the first Northern Division team to win all four games against California schools in one season.

Oregon also broke the Memorial Coliseum jinx, but this week the Webfoots have a jinx on Prothro to keep and thoughts of the Pasadena clash against Ohio State don't officially begin until homecoming 1957 is over.
