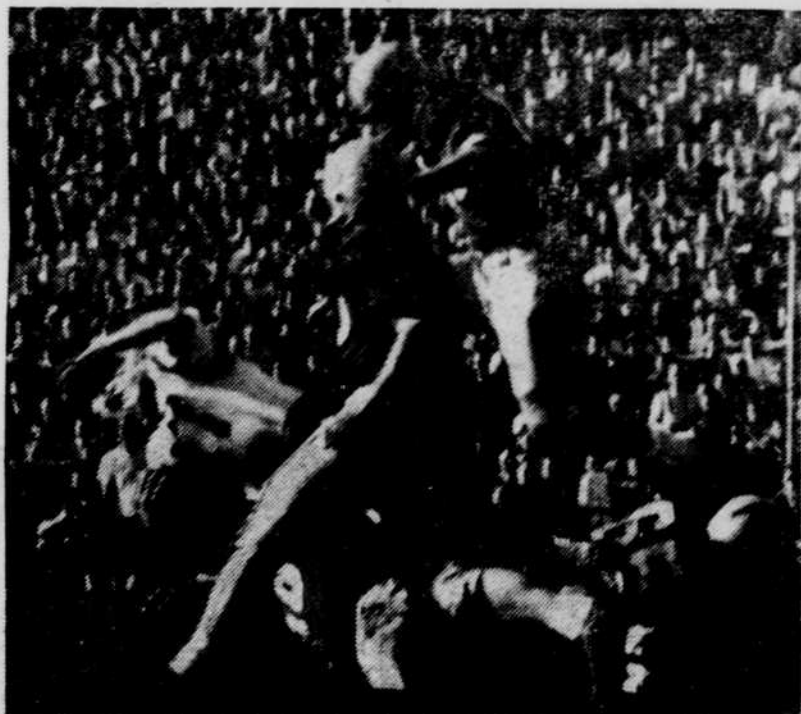


# Webfoot Desire Suprises Bucks

account for 52 yards out of 63, and kept the Buck cause going with that previously mentioned fourth-down splurge.

Things finally did bog down on the 17, and Sutherland booted his fourth and biggest field goal of the year practically from Jack Morris' earlier footprint.

## Oregon Bounces Back

That was the end of scoring, but the Ducks didn't know it—they roared into OSU territory twice before the best of the postwar Rose Bowl was over, and both times breaks—not Ohio—stopped them.

In the first surge, terrific passes from Crabtree to Kimbrough and from West to Stover had the Buckeyes grabbing, but after Stover had snagged his third pass of the drive, he was hit from behind on the OSU 14 just as he changed sides with the ball, which squirted free and was lost.

Did the Ducks give up the ghost? Here's what they did: they held Ohio State to 31 yards in 12 plays (seven by Galen Cisco), stopped the Ohioans completely with 4:29 left in supposedly the Bucks' best quarter, and starter their own gallant effort with a first-time double reverse good for nine yards and a great roar from the stands.

## Stover Leads Final Threat

Another incredible reverse, this time springing a pass to Ron Stover, and a pass interference penalty moved Oregon to the OSU 47 with 2:30 left. But some lost yardage and a clipping penalty nullified a scintillating Stover catch on the OSU 49. Frank Kremblas fell down twice for Ohio State and the game was over.

Thirty-seven years had elapsed since Oregon last appeared in the Rose Bowl, and with the current PCC squabbles, the Ducks may never get another opportunity. No matter—who can ever forget the memorable showing of a team that was all heart and guts, and had faith in itself.
