Nuclear School Proposed by AEC

WASHINGTON (AP)—The University of Washington and Atomic Energy Commission were reported Wednesday by Sen. Jackson, D-Wash., near agreement on a contract for the University to take over operation of the AEC's nuclear engineering school at the Hanford, Wash., atomic works.

Jackson said that under the contract the University would take charge of the school in July. It has been operated by the AEC for specialized courses given students from the University of Washington, Washington State College and the University of Idaho.

Establishment of another nuclear college near Hanford for postgraduate work was proposed

earlier in the week by a representative of the Pasco-Kennewick-Richland Tri-Cities area.
