Campaign Starts For Doomed Baby

Plans for coordinating a campus fund-raising campaign to assist a 16-month-old Glenwood baby who is suffering from a rare brain-destroying malady were announced today.

Representatives of Phi Gamma Delta were scheduled to speak today at noon to members of all on-campus organizations. College students will be asked to make donations to the special trust fund that has been established at the Eugene main branch of the First National Bank.

Frances, the youngest of four children of Mr. and Mrs. Virgil Van Arnam, 4095 1/2 Concord St., is suffering from the exceedingly rare disease of "phenylketonuria," a disease in which the body's digestion of protein is disturbed.

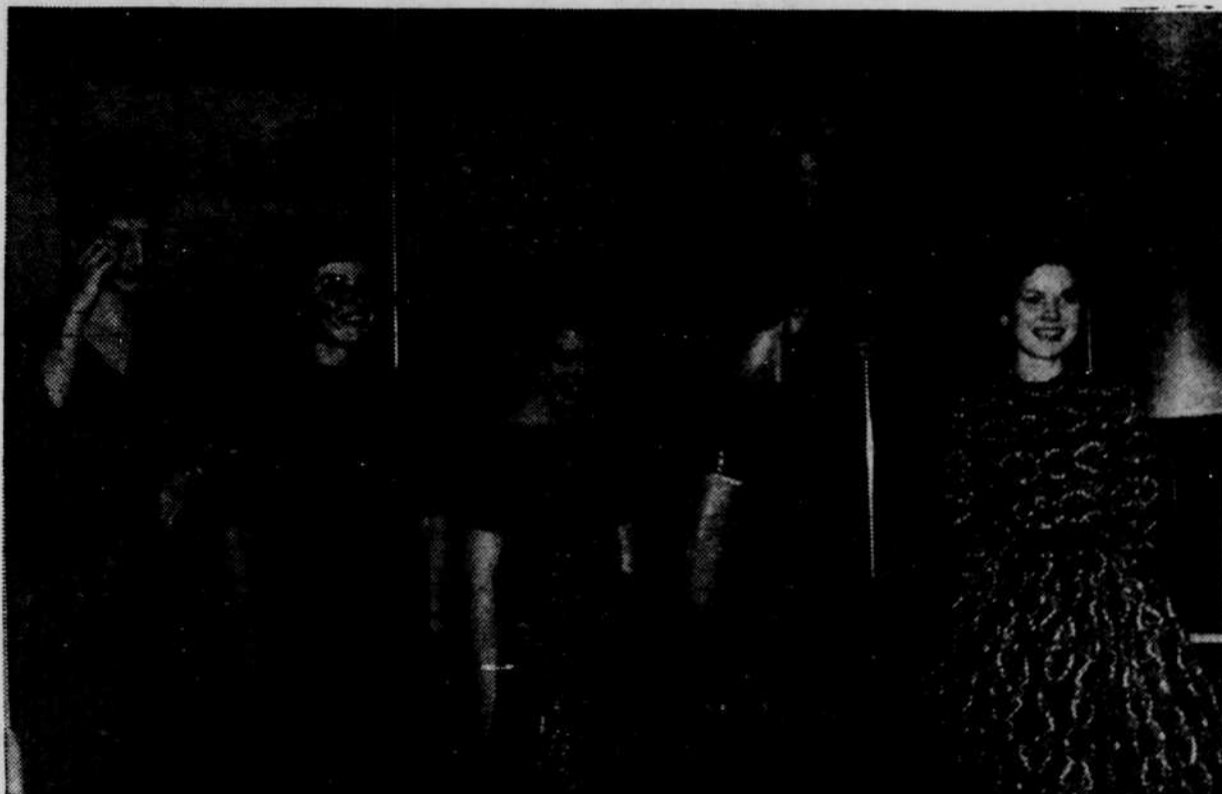
Without a special food preparation, Ketonil, which costs \$25 a pound, the baby will be doomed to a future of mental retardation.

Doctors say a pound of the

preparation will last about four days and estimate that the child will have to eat Ketonil for the next two to three years before the biochemical abnormalities in her body can be corrected.
