## Women conduct rush evaluation

In an effort to find the overall opinion of sorority women on the subject of a pre-school rush program, Panhellenic has sent petitions to each of the campus' 16 national sororities to be signed by women who favor such a change.

If the results are affirmative, the signed petitions will be presented to the various departments of the administration for their appraisal.

Panhellenic president Joan Long predicts a favorable showing. Although only three petitions had been returned by Wednesday evening with the deadline set for 5 p.m. today, those returned showed a great majority of the members of each house in favor of the suggestion.

Miss Long also noted the fact that for the past two years Panhellenic has voted unanimously for pre-school rush with the request each time being turned down by the administration.

#### Individual basis

It was decided that instead of having each house vote on the petition as a single unit, each individual woman should have a vote, with the result possibly accepted as more significant.

Included in the five reasons for pre-school rush as printed on each petition are the statements that a combination of rush and either New Student Week or classes "places a tremendous mental and physical strain on both rushees and sorority women" and that there is "not enough time for Panhellenic personnel to give each rushee the consideration and help she deserves."

#### Separate petitions

Two separate petitions have been formed by the combined feelings of the City and campus Panhellenics, one for signatures of initiated members and the other for pledges' signatures.

Both petitions contain the statement that pre-school rush "necessitates coming back to school four to five days earlier" and also that those who sign are "willing to expend the additional time and/or money" to return at this earlier date.
