

UO gridders meet WSU

 Oregon vs. Washington State University.

This return game between two of the Northwest's top collegiate football teams is a contest that football fans in the Northwest have been waiting to see since the Ducks won the first contest in Eugene 14-6.

The first game was a thrilling encounter and was even closer than the score indicates. Oregon scored their final touchdown in the final 30 seconds of play after holding a slim 7-6 lead throughout most of the fourth quarter.

Although neither head coach wants to mention the words Rose Bowl this game will have a great bearing on the Pacific Coast representative in this famed post season classic.

Washington State will enter the game with a 5-2 win-lost mark while Oregon goes into the important contest with a 7-1 mark. Washington State which just missed going to the Rose Bowl for the past two years will be aiming at the Ducks with all they have.

Coach Jim Sutherland's Cougars have vivid memories of their one loss to the Ducks this year.

But the game that the people of the Palouse country still remember is Oregon's famous 14-13 win over the Cougars two years ago in Pullman; that was the year Oregon journeyed south to Pasadena on New

Years Day. A final conversion attempt by WSU hit the crossbar giving Oregon a one point triumph.

Last year the Cougars spoiled Oregon's Homecoming with a 6-0 triumph over Len Casanova's squad. The Ducks will journey to the Palouse country with ideas of doing the same thing to the Cougars this year, for Saturday's clash is WSU's Homecoming game.
