### Off-campus living rules set

Due to the increased enrollment of women at the University, women are now allowed to live off-campus. Apartments, private homes, and boarding houses are included in the approved off-campus residences.

The University has, however, set aside certain rules that must

be met, before students are able to move off-campus. The girls must be 21 years of age by January 1, 1961 (this applies only to those girls wishing to move off winter term); the girls must have their parent's approval; their housing must be approved by the Dean's office; and all sorority women must first receive approval from their respective Greek organizations before the Dean's office will grant permission. These rules will be enforced by AWS.

All women who will be moving off campus or are now living off-campus should register in the Dean of Women's office. This is in case of emergencies and it is very important that the Dean's office is able to contact all women living off-campus.

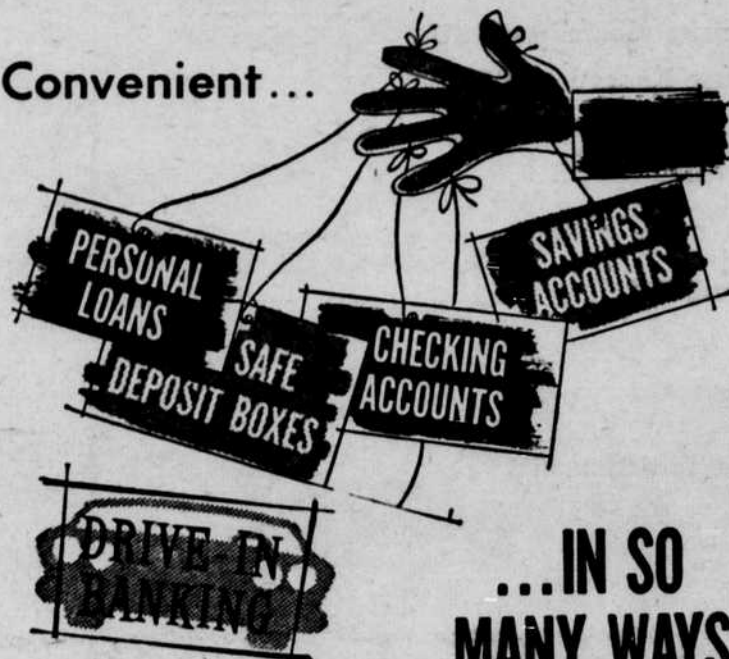
