TODAY'S starter is sophomore Bob Berry, who did a fine job on the Frosh squad in 1960, but hasn't played anywhere near the competition he'll run up against this afternoon.

His replacements, Doug Post, Ron Veres, and Pat Morton, are also strangers to Varsity competition.

SO IF THE Webfoots have an early-season weakness, it appears to be at quarterback. Every other position is stocked with veterans.

Ends Kent Petersen and Greg Willener are letterman. So are tackles Steve Barnett and Dennis Prozinski. So are guards Mickey Ordning and Mike Rose. So is center Joe Clesceri. So are halfbacks Ben Brown and Mickey Bruce. And so is fullback Bruce Snyder.

AND SEVERAL of their replacements are lettermen.

But there isn't a single veteran at quarterback.

If Berry or one of the other youngsters can come through this early in the year, the Varsity stands an excellent chance of avenging last year's 13-12 defeat.

As was the case in 1960, head coach Norm Van Brocklin has a lot of talent at every position.

HIS ALUMNI squad will be handicapped by lack of practice and many of the players won't be able to compete for very long against the better-conditioned Varsity—but don't count them out.

At quarterback, Van Brocklin can call on several ex-Webfoots stars besides himself. Foremost among them are last year's team leader, Dave Grosz, and the star of the 1958 Rose Bowl game, Jack Crabtree.

THE REST of the backfield includes such names as Dave Grayson, Cleveland Jones, Dave Powell, and Oregon's all-time leading ground gainer, Jim Shanley.

The line has three big tackles who could probably make any college first team in the nation if they were still eligible. They are John Wilcox, Darrell Aschbacher, and Riley Mattson.

CENTER Bob Peterson was highly regarded in his undergraduate days, and so were ends Alden Kimbrough and Greg Althenhofen.
