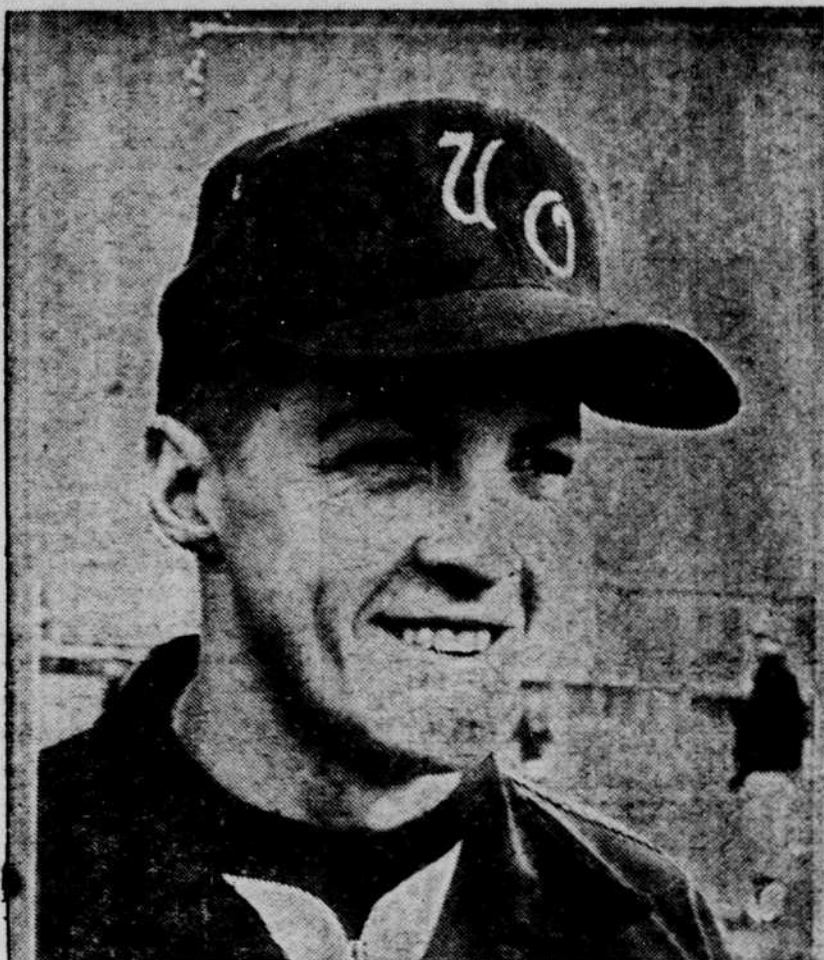




LEON HAYES had a big day for Oregon in the Webfoots' 19-6 win over Idaho. Hayes collected three hits in four times at bat and drove in five runs.

The Oregon Ducks started their six-game road trip successfully Friday.

DON KIRSCH's Webfoots massacred the Idaho Vandals 19-6 at Moscow. Earlier in the season, the Ducks squeezed out two one-run victories over the Vandals by scores of 8-7 and 2-1.

Friday, the Ducks rapped out

20 hits and batted around in two different innings. They led 18-0 in the eighth inning before the Vandals reached starter Fred Ballard for six runs.

JON SWANSON relieved Ballard and held Idaho in check. Ballard got the win, making his season's mark five wins and only one loss. Pat Townsend, who lost a narrow decision to Ballard at Eugene, was the victim of the Oregon assault.

Although Oregon got an average of more than two hits per inning, the game was sloppily played. The Webfoots committed six errors and the Vandals made five miscues.

LEON HAYES was Oregon's big hitter. The senior shortstop raised his season's average from .192 to .232 by banging out three hits in four trips.

Today, the Vandals and Ducks will play again. Kirsch will probably start Denny Peterson (4-0) against Steve Hinckley of Idaho. Peterson has no record in Northern Division play this year.

BALLARD is the top ND hurler with a 2-0 mark. As of last week, he also led the league with a snappy 1.03 earned run average.

Choral Groups to Present Concert in SU Ballroom

The choral music of Milton Dieterich, Oregon composer, will be presented by 300 voices of University choral organizations in a concert at 2:30 p.m., Sunday, May 14, in the SU ballroom.

THE GROUPS participating in the concert which is being presented as a part of the Junior Week activities include the University Women's Chorus, University Men's Chorus, and University Chorus, conducted by Thomas Lewis, graduate student in music from Wheeler; University Chorale, conducted by Max Risner of the Music School faculty; University Madrigal Singers, conducted by Argil Shrock, a senior from Hubbard; and University Singers, under the direction of James Friesen, a senior from Eugene.

The chorale groups will sing a variety of Dieterich's compositions from "Vive Las Cookery laid," a group of novelty numbers; and "O God of Love," a collection of sacred music, which has been performed and broadcasted by the famed Salt Lake City Mormon Choir.

THE CHORAL groups will join under conductor Max Risner singing Dieterich's "Benedictus" as the finale.

Dieterich, who has published more than 100 compositions, has been on the University of Oregon Music Faculty since 1946. He is currently an assistant professor of music at the University.

HE RECEIVED his bachelor of music from Grinnell College, Grinnell, Ia., and his master of music degree from the Eastman School of Music, Rochester, N.Y.

Choir director at St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Eugene, Dieterich has composed and arranged sacred and secular music for

men's, women's and mixed vocal groups. His compositions are used by church choirs, and high school and college choruses across the United States.

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
