

Model UN Conference Opens Here Thursday

Approximately 500 Oregon high school students, all members of the International Relations Leagues at their schools, will participate in a Model United Nations conference at the University, Feb. 22-24.

The MUN session is the 15th annual conference sponsored by the University's Institute of International Studies and Overseas Administration and the International Relations Committee of the Oregon Education Association.

HELMUT SONNENFELDT of Washington, D.C., chief of the International Political Activities Division of the U.S. State Department, will be a guest speaker. He will talk on "American-Soviet Disarmament Negotiations" Saturday at 9:30 a.m. in McArthur Court.

Friday at 11 a.m. Aaron Novick, Director of the University's Institute of Molecular Biology, will speak on "The Relative Nuclear

Arms." AT 2:45 p.m. Friday John C. Livingston, associate professor of government at Sacramento State College, will address the conference on "Disarmament and American Foreign Policy."

Carl Hintz, University Librarian who recently returned from a sabbatical in India, will be guest speaker at the Friday night banquet. His topic will be "Mehendra Singh: Class of 1962."

Persecution Claimed

WASHINGTON (UPI) — U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations, Adlai Stevenson, in a letter made public Tuesday, said reports of Soviet persecution of Jews are "shocking." Stevenson wrote New York Democratic Congressman Herbert Zelenko that he is "ready to do everything the (State) Department thinks I can do to be of help" in condemning Russia for the alleged mistreatment.

Music Recital Set Thursday

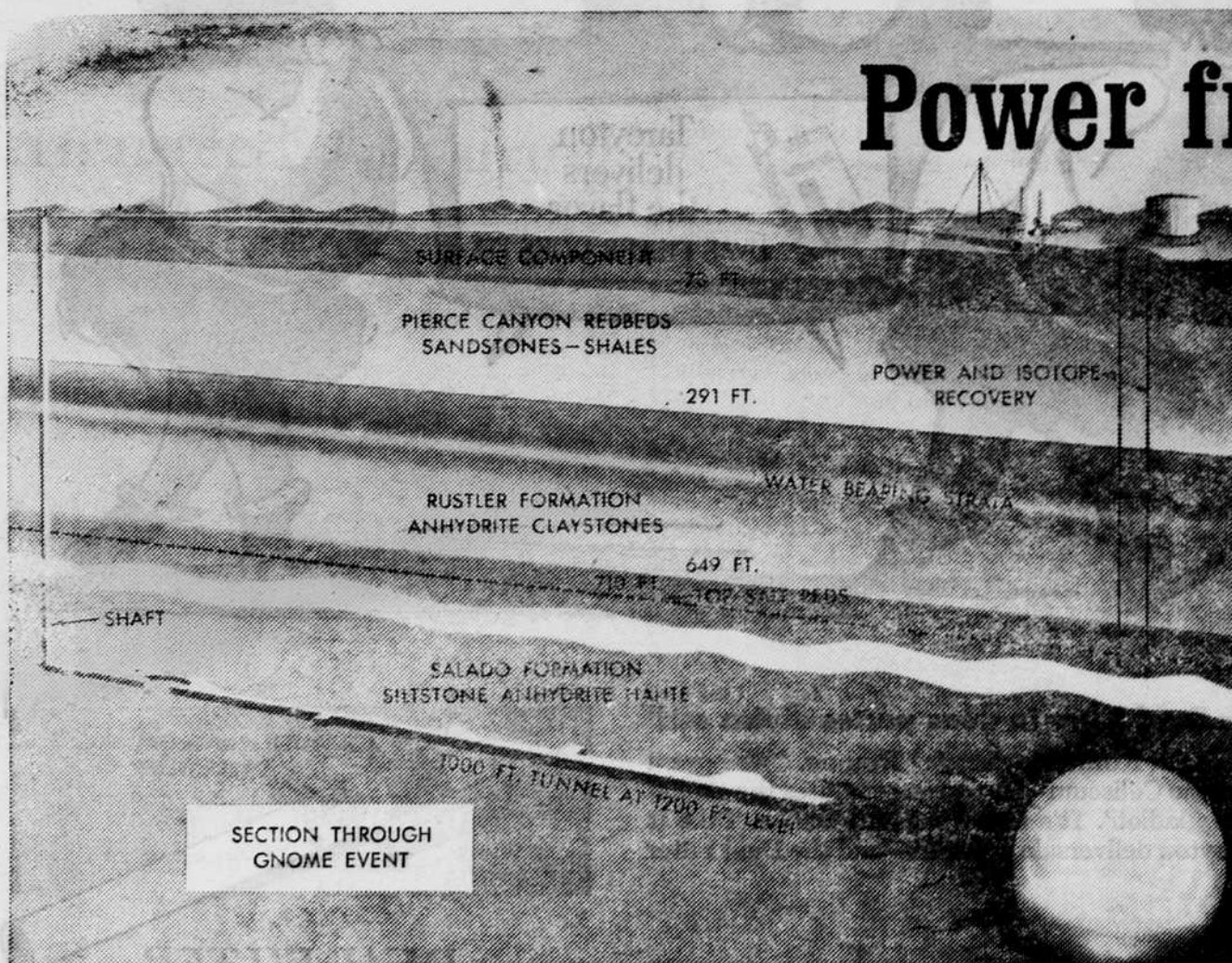
