

UO Splits Twin Bill With WSU Cougars

Oregon's varsity baseball team split a doubleheader with the Washington State Cougars Saturday at Pullman, losing the first game 7-4, but winning the nightcap 5-1.

WSU hurler Bob Stephens spaced 7 hits evenly as the Cougars took the opener. The Ducks jumped off to an early lead on a leadoff homer by John Livingston, and singles by Sandy Nosler and Eric Hardin, and a squeeze bunt by Ken Jensen made it 2-0 at the end of the second frame.

WSU came back with a homer by Zeke Blockinger after the UO scored two more runs in the fourth, and won it in the fifth

with four runs sending the Duck's Arba Ager to cover.

In the second game, Nosler drove in two runs with a single, and Cal Dean contributed a home run. The Webfoots won it in the sixth with pitcher Robbie Snow driving in the final two runs with a single.

The split put the Ducks out of reach of the Oregon State Beavers who are now 11-2 with but two games remaining on the slate.
