Actually the Trotters led all the way and besides providing basketball thrills, they went one up on the entertainment work! with a fine display of mirth and merriment.

Bobby "Showboat" Hall waddled up and down the court to take comedy honors for the winners and Bob Wagner led the scoring parade with 24 counters.

Former University of Portland great, Bill Garner, played against the Trotters and scored 6 points

for the San Franciscans. Leroy Gibson was their high scorer with 22.

Some very good variety acts were presented by the Globetrotters before the game and at halftime including a table tennis match between two world champions.

More comedy was provided by the referee who was right in the thick of the action although the basketballers were generally one step ahead of him.

Actually it wasn't the superior basketball of the Globetrotters that gave them the victory but it was the fact that they paid both the opposing team and the referee.

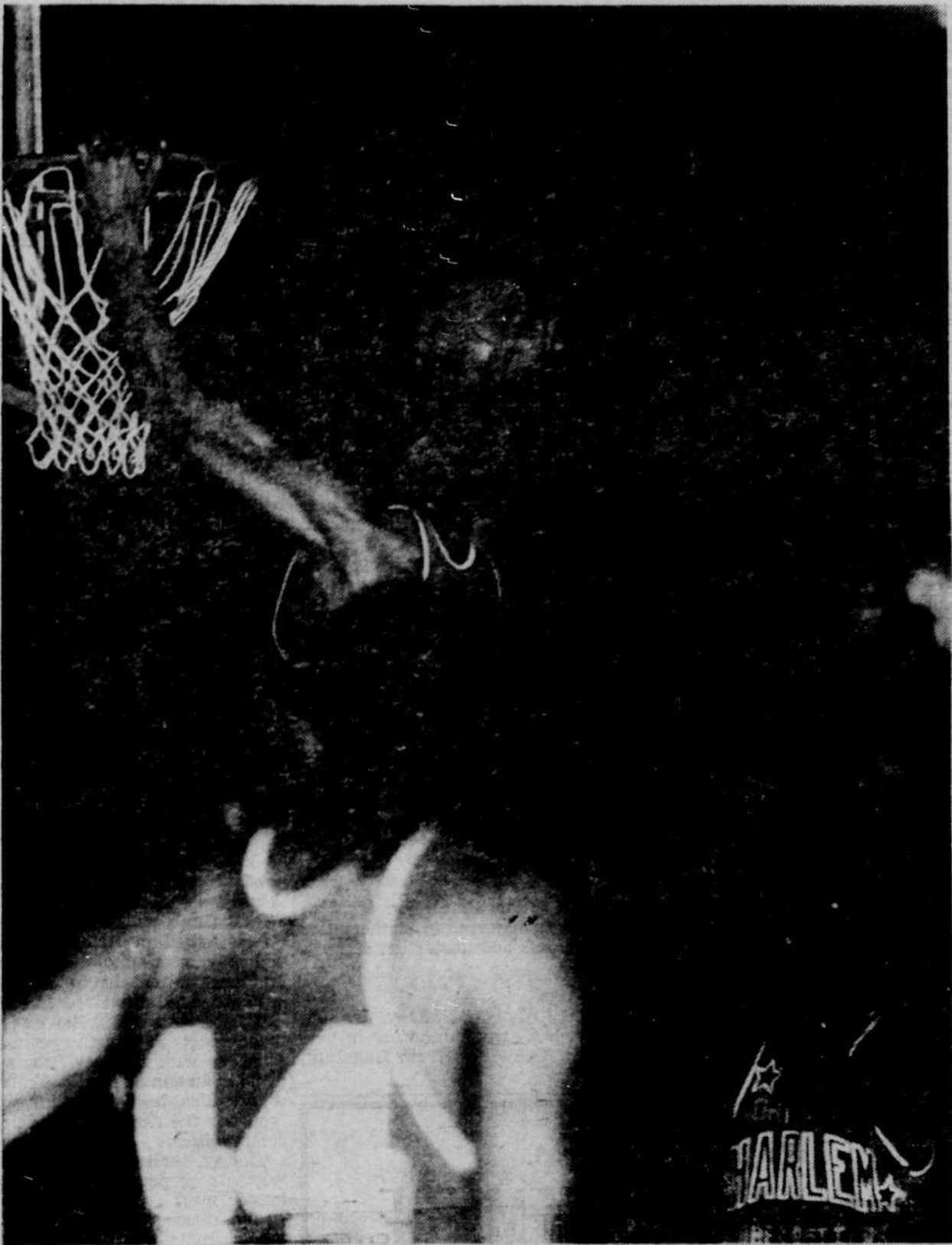

Soccer Club

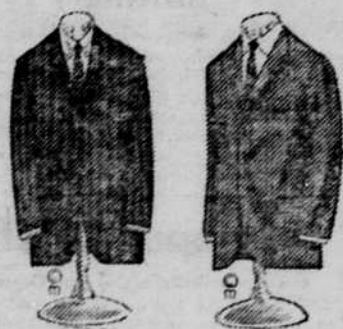
The Soccer Club will hold an organizational meeting this evening in the Student Union. Time and room number will be posted on the SU Bulletin.
