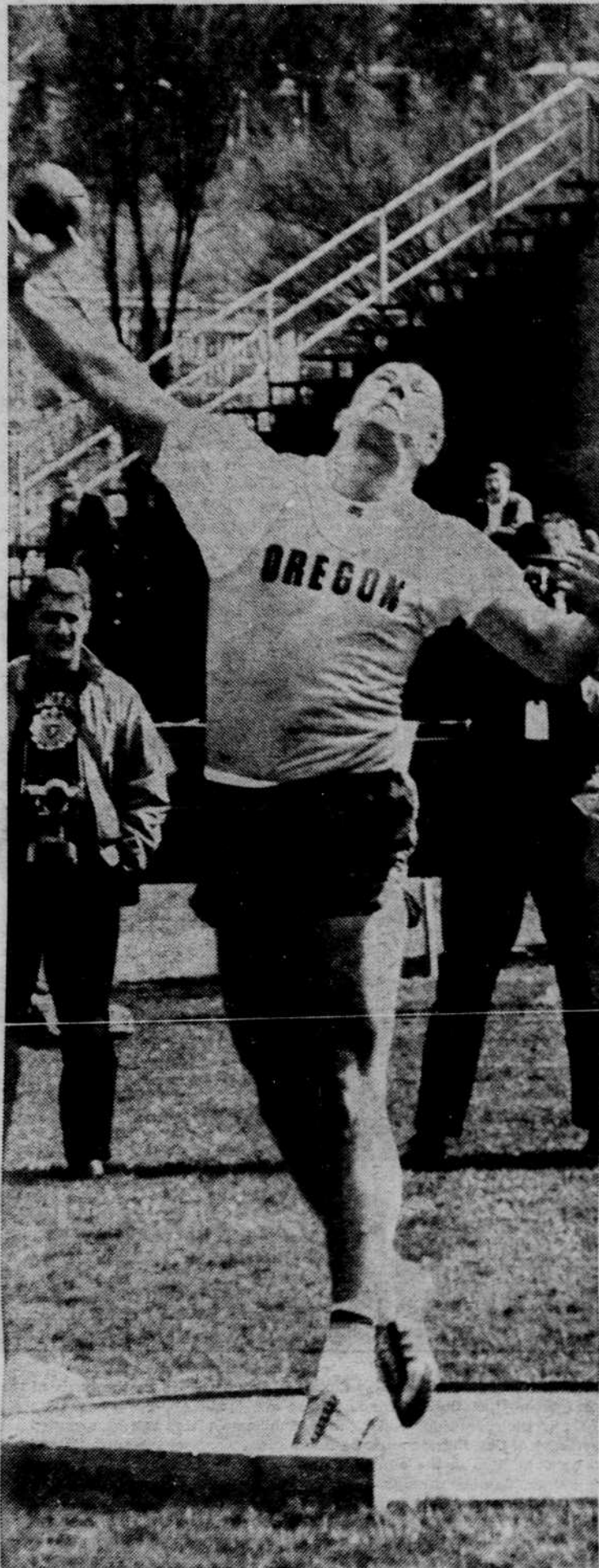
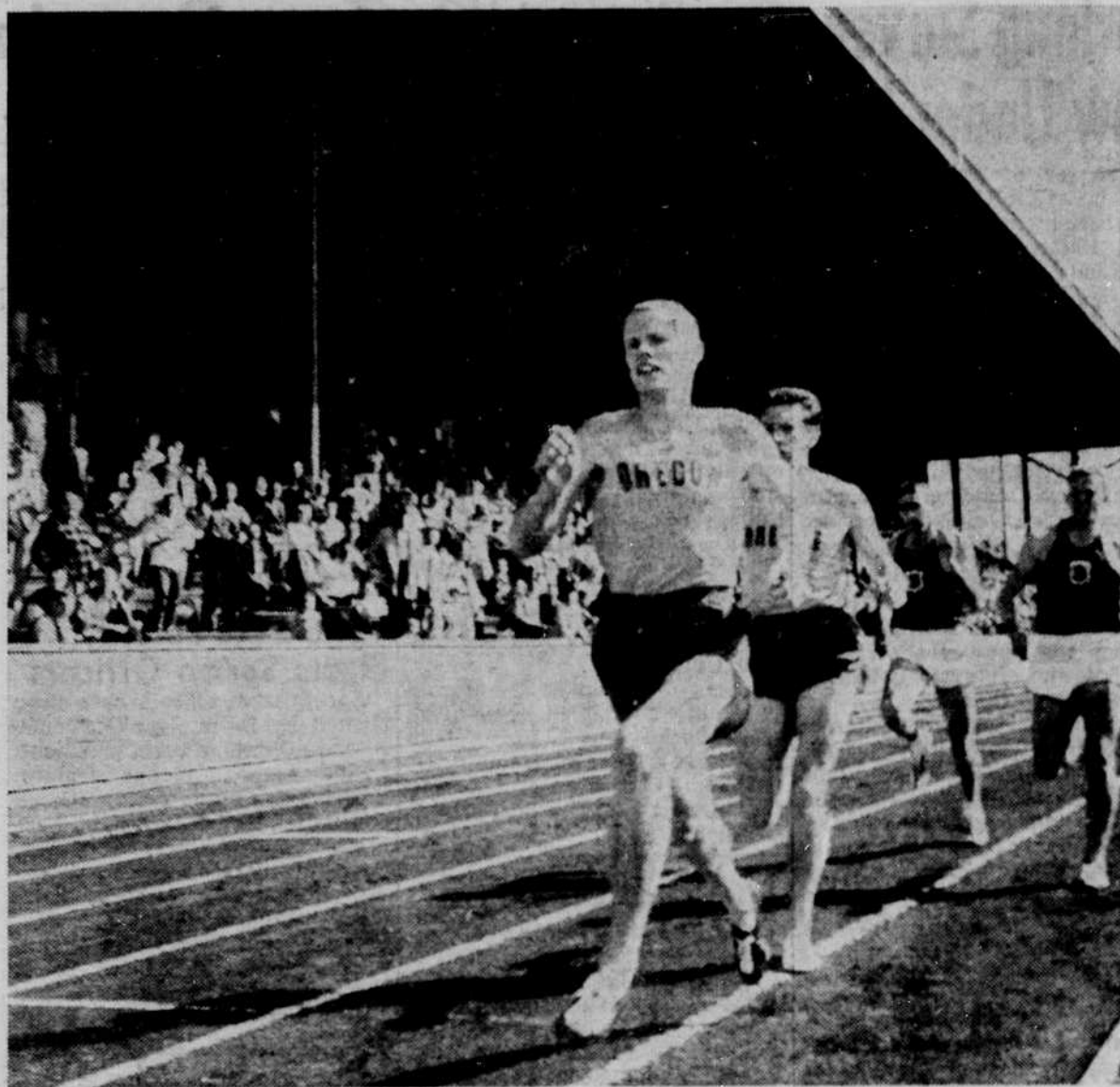




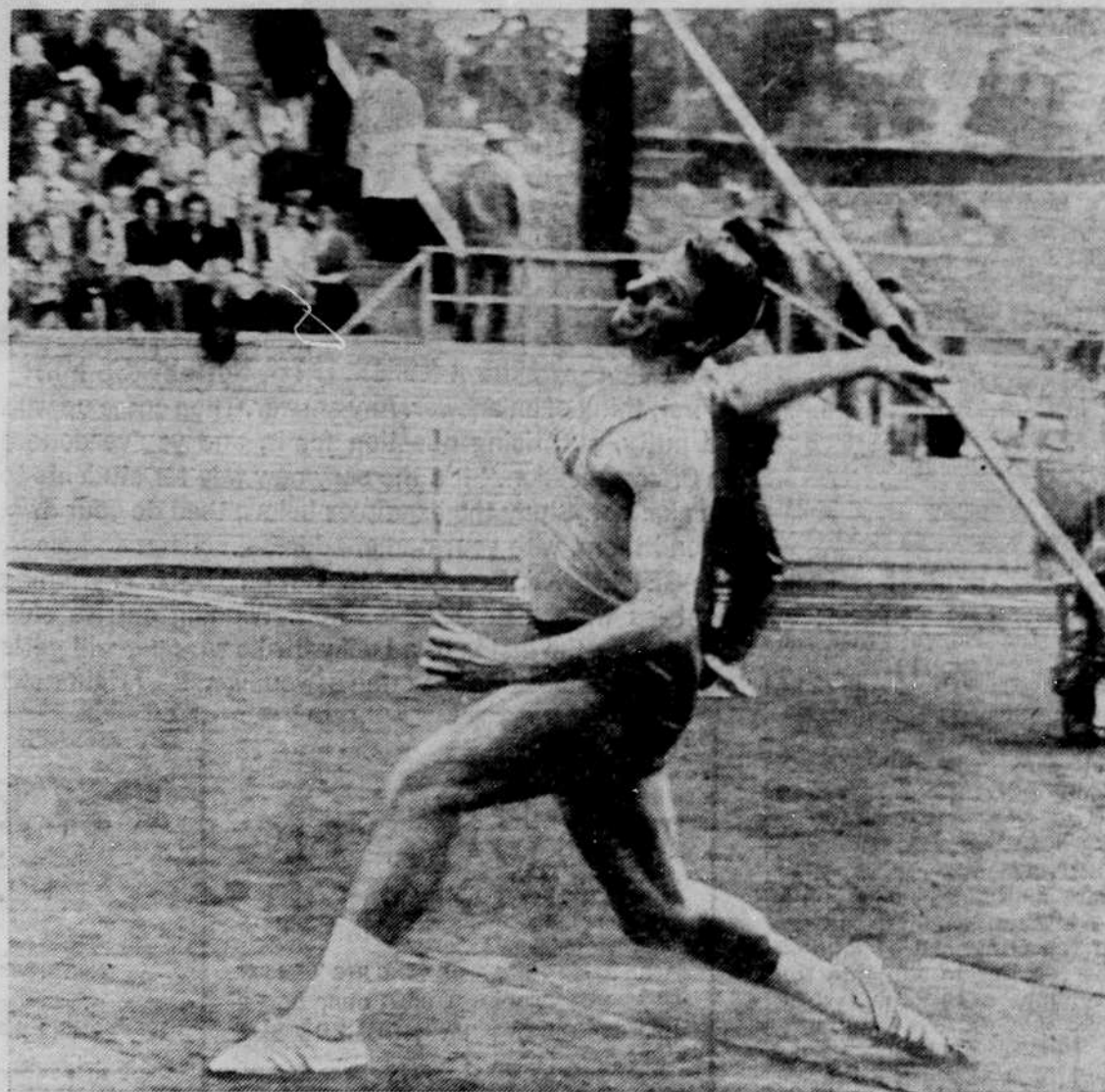
Establishing a new school record in the shot put is Dave Steen who tossed the shot 61'3 3/4". His put bettered the second place finisher's try by well over five inches.

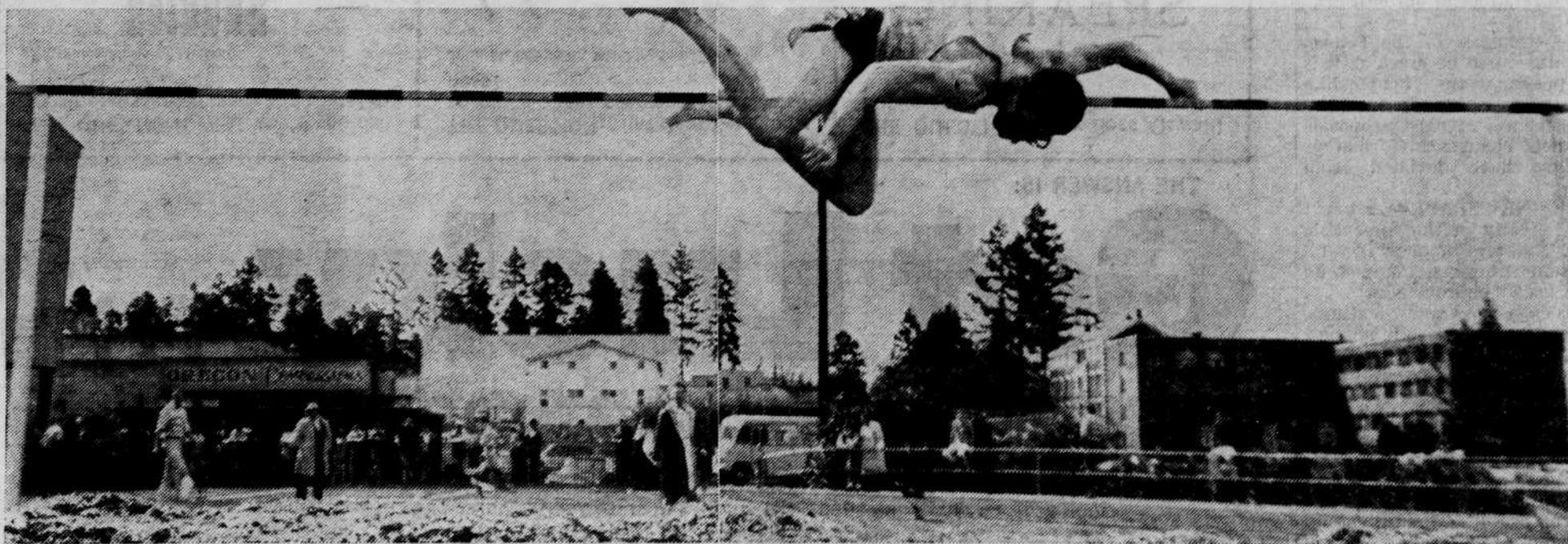
