An almost unlimited variety of designs including plain colors, stripes, flowers, checks, and prints are available in both sheets and towels.

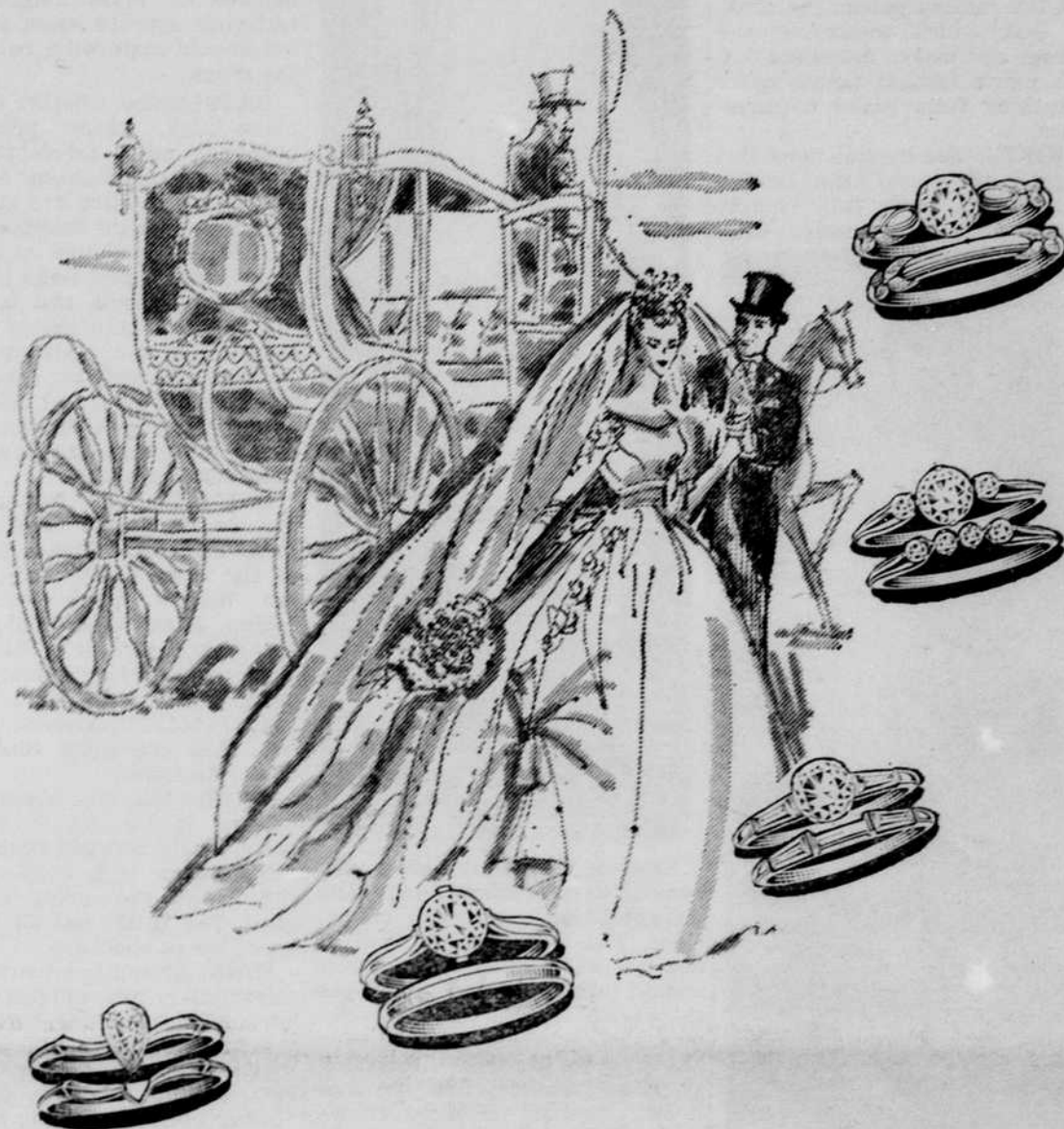
Coordination is the key to planning a linen trousseau. Shades of one color can be used in different patterns to give harmony. Plain and patterned linens are
