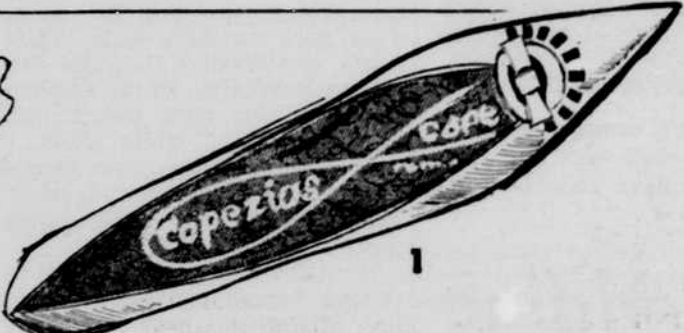
GROVE-DUNN

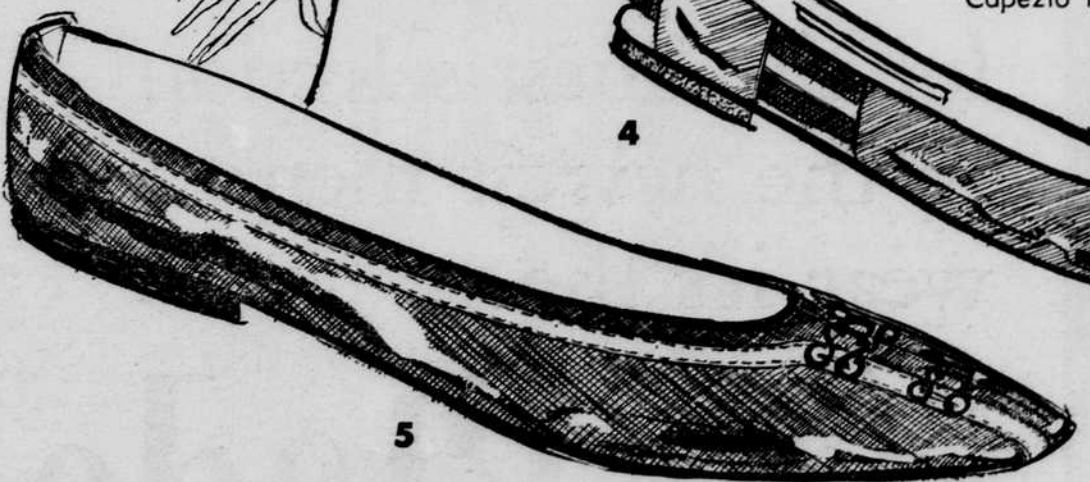
