



Student Development Fund

The proposed forest campsite, which will be purchased through student breakage fee donations, will provide a recreation area that will offer privacy as well as relaxation.

The Student Development Fund to purchase the land for the campsite will begin tonight with a kick-off dessert for outstanding campus leaders. Speakers in behalf of the drive will include President Arthur Flemming, former ASUO President Dan Williams, and Lee Coffey.

The Student Development Fund drive marks the first time students at the University have been able to contribute directly to a specific recreation project. It is unique, too, in that students who contribute to it this year will be able to see tangible results of their donations next year.

When completed, the recreation area will have facilities for shooting, archery, swimming, water skiing, picnicking, field games, fishing, sailing, and canoeing. There will be year-round access to the area, and it will be within an hour and a half's drive from campus.

What The Individual Can Do...

Students can contribute to the purchase of the University of Oregon Campsite by filling out the pledge card and returning it to his house president or mailing it to the business office. Should a student incur losses that would require him to bring his breakage fee up to fifteen dollars again, he may withdraw his donation. Should a student wish merely to make a donation to unrestricted funds of the Development Fund, he may so indicate.
