Haitian Dictator Supported By 'Pistol Packing Force'

The black-skinned, white-haired president of Haiti is a physician-turned-dictator who perpetuates himself with the aid of a pistol-packing force called "Tonton Macoute."

Francois Duvalier, product of an African-French-Indian ethnic background, has even been known to strap on a pistol and do some of the shooting himself.

The terrorist Tonton Macoute, which means "bogeymen," is made up of bully boys who swagger through Port Au Prince in blue jeans and sport shirts, looking out for "Papa Doc's" interests. They reportedly are adept at all forms of persuasion from "voluntary" contributions for Duvalier's personal projects to torture for his enemies.

There are about 10,000 of these "bogeymen" in Haiti, as compared with the little Caribbean country's army of 5,000. Duvalier has systematically stripped the army of its best officers since he first took office in October of 1957.

Duvalier currently is observing a "month of gratefulness" for a bit of political sleight-of-hand he

executed two years ago. He declared himself re-elected to a new six-year term two years before his old term was to have expired the middle of this month (May).

Mounting violence in the Haitian capital city has accompanied the approach of that date.

An outfit calling itself the United Revolutionary Forces has announced that on May 15th it will carry out a "dry cleaning" operation against the 56-year-old "tyrant-vooodooist" Duvalier.

Haiti has charged Dominican Republic connivance in an assassination plot against "Papa Doc," he likes the peasants to call him that, a plot which failed but led to the deaths of a chauffeur and two bodyguards watching over Duvalier's children.

The U.S. embassy officially has warned some 1500 Americans to store up food and water and stay off downtown streets. And although some easing is reported, the situation remains potentially explosive.

The Haitian government has pressed a hate campaign against both the United States and the Dominican Republic. Duvalier has threatened that any uprising

against him will produce a "Himmler of corpses."

U.S. taxpayers have given Haiti \$100 million in aid since 1946 and the most to show for it is a small dam, some road repairs and progress in eliminating the tropical yaws.

About a year ago, indicating its obvious distaste for Duvalier, the United States cut off its Haitian aid but has remained in a quandary since over what further action might be taken.

The Duvalier regime represents the very opposite of the democratic ideals pursued by the Latin American Alliance for Progress. Duvalier is in some respects like the late Dominican dictator Trujillo who ruled the rest of the island of Hispaniola with an iron hand for 30 years, until he was shot to death two years ago.

Like Trujillo, Duvalier has his name plastered all over Haiti, proclaiming himself to be the "pacificateur."

What to do about Duvalier is a knotty problem. Extreme action against Haiti might only further the misery of its four million inhabitants whose living conditions already are among the worst in the world.

CENTO Reviewed

PAKISTAN (UPI) — Secretary of State Rusk pointed out the advantages of belonging to the Central Treaty Organization (CENTO) to member ministers meeting in Pakistan.

Rusk told the meeting in Karachi that no member nation of any of the western alliances, CENTO, NATO, or SEATO, had ever been the victim of Communist aggression.

However, Rusk warned that the entire free world still is "under the gun" of the Communist menace, despite removal of the major threat Cuba presented last fall.

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May Day Boycotted

MOSCOW (UPI) — A spokesman at the American embassy in Moscow says Ambassador Foy Kohler and his staff are boycotting Soviet May Day celebrations.

The celebrations are scheduled to begin shortly in Red Square. Visiting Premier Castro, a hero in the eyes of Russians, is honored guest at the celebrations.

The American embassy in the Red capital did not say why Kohler and his staff had decided to boycott the ceremonies, but it is apparent that the presence of Castro weighed heavily in the decision.

This will be the first Russian May Day boycotted by the American diplomatic corps in Moscow since 1933, the year the U.S. established relations with the Communist government.

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Walk Scheduled

CHATTANOOGA, TENN. (UPI) — Two integration groups in Chattanooga say they will start out tomorrow on a walk to commemorate the death of integrationist William Moore. The walk will follow generally the same route Moore was taking when he was ambushed and slain along an Alabama highway. Alabama Governor George Wallace has opposed the walk, saying it will "serve no useful purpose."

U.S. Wins Medals

SAO PAULO, BRAZIL (UPI) — The United States bagged four more gold medals at the Pan American Games in Sao Paulo, Brazil today. The performance upped the U.S. gold medal total to 68. Jeffrey Fishback of Belmont, California, won a surprise victory in the three-thousand meter steeplechase, but the U.S. finished second behind Cuba in the baseball tournament.

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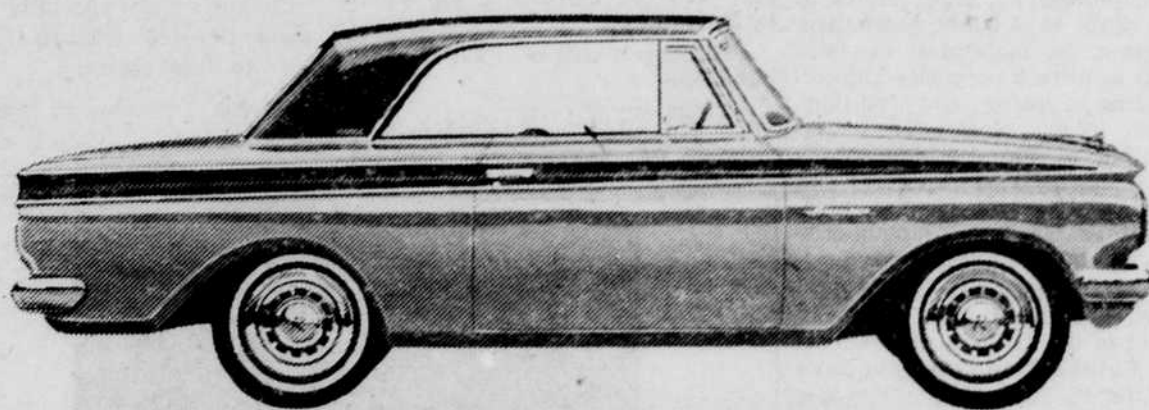
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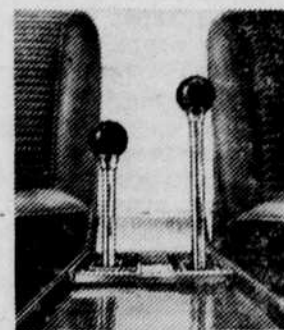


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
