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A 4-Minute Mile? Burleson to Try

Oregon track fans will get their first chance of the year to see Dyrol Burleson run today.

At 5:30 p.m. at Hayward field Burleson will attempt to run the mile in under four minutes. His coach, Bill Bowerman, said that if the weather is good he is sure Burleson can run under four minutes.

Opposition will probably come from the Oregon freshman track team and Emerald Empire Athletic Assn. runners.

Since it requires at least three events to have a meet there will be at least two other events. For any record to be approved, it must be set in a meet.

Burleson, the former Oregon distance runner, is the reigning AAU mile champ. He is the fourth fastest miler in history with an all-time best 3:56.0.

Burleson also holds the Oregon record in the mile with a 3:57.6 and the school two-mile record with an 8:42.5.

No admission will be charged, but donations to the Olympic fund will be asked for.

Entries can be picked up at room 301 SU or by contacting living organization representatives. Entry lists must be turned in by 5 p.m. Friday.

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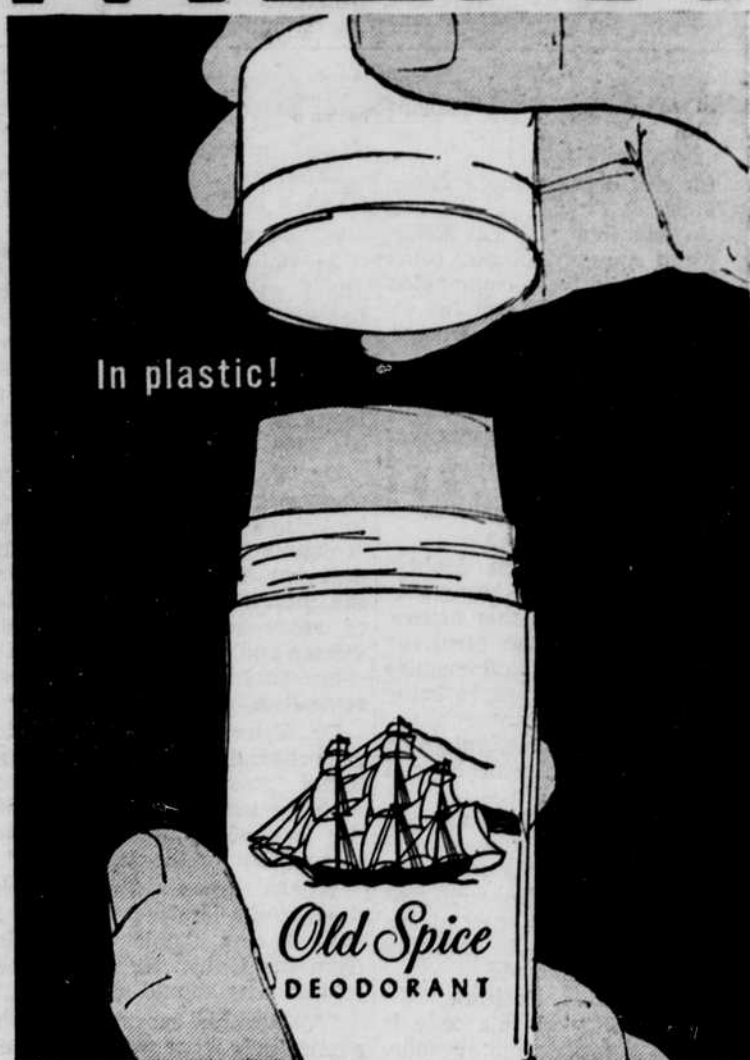
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
