**Lampard Leads UO Hitting Stats**

Sophomore Keith Lampard leads Oregon hitters with a .339 average, in homeruns with five, plus a team leading total of 16 RBI's.

Right behind Lampard with averages over .300 are Ron Delplanche .323, Bob Porter .321, Don Banderas .310, and Steve Bunker at .306.

In addition, Delplanche is second in RBI's with 15 followed by Dennis Baldrige with 13. Delplanche has driven in many of his runs with his extra base hits as he has a total of eight doubles and three triples.

On the mound, Wally Palmberg leads in most innings worked with 33 and he boasts a 2.70 ERA. Jerry Gjesvold holds the number one ERA at 0.72 but he has worked only 12 innings.

Lampard, the Duck's most versatile player, actually has the best ERA per innings worked with a 1.53 mark in 23 innings.
