

## Second VISTA Group Leaves

The second group of VISTA volunteers who trained this summer at the University will leave today for permanent assignments in their year of service in the national War on Poverty. VISTA is Volunteers in Service to America.

The completion ceremony and luncheon for about 40 persons who successfully completed their training will be today at noon in the Student Union. Dean of Administration William C. Jones will address the volunteers.

Director of VISTA on the campus is R. N. Lowe, professor of education at the University.

During their six weeks of training, the trainees attended lectures and discussions led by VISTA staff members and participated in field observation. The volunteers come from various regions in the United States and range in age from 18 to 75.

Season ticket buyers have two options for the series. Tickets may be purchased for the entire se-

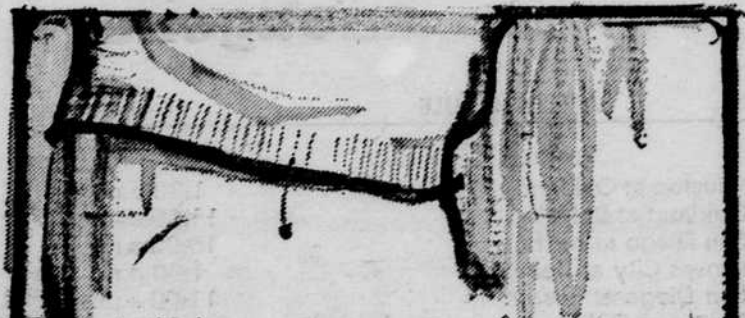

the Alma Trio, a group organized 18 years at the Alma Estate of Yehudi Menuhin in the Santa Cruz Mountains. Members of the trio are Adolph Baller, pianist; Andor Toth, violinist; and Gabor Rejto, cellist.
