

Trovato Snaps Record, Ducks Win

often Saturday night in Ute stadium due to Oregon penalties. Officials called the Ducks 15 times for a total of 169 yards, close to Utah's total yardage mark of 192 yards.

Coley mentioned, "With our type of attack, there's more of a tendency to clip. We do a lot of running around and throwing the long pass."

The game remained scoreless through the first quarter, but the Ducks struck twice in the second. After gaining possession of the ball on their own 49 after a Utah offensive pass interference call, Arian Elms carried for 25 yards to the Utah 26.

Eight plays later Cress scored the game's first TD after grabbing a pass from Trovato.

Elms Scores TD

Les Palm intercepted a misguided Utah pass on the Redskin 48 after the kickoff. Trovato then hit split end Ray Palm for a 47-yard pass play and, three plays later, Elms scored for the Ducks. Utah scored in the remaining

minutes of the first half on a 15-yard run by halfback Ben Wells.

Oregon moved into a two-touchdown lead again in the third quarter on the Trovato-to-Bunker 71-yard pass play, but Utah came within seven points with quarterback Rich Groth's four-yard pass to Ken Chelin.

Oregon got that one back on Cress' second touchdown of the night, a one-yard leap in the fourth quarter. The big play in

that drive was Trovato's pass to Bunker for 37 yards, to the Utah 15.

Place kicker Marc Scholl ended the scoring for Oregon with a 25-yard field goal, to add to his

four previous PAT boots. After a field goal and a couple of extra points in the Pitt game, Scholl ran his total to 12 points for the season.

The Duck defense proved strong

Saturday, stopping several Utah drives with two fumble recoveries and four pass interceptions. Les Palm picked off two pass interceptions, while Dave Tobey and Cam Molter nabbed one each.
