

Freshmen Teams Set Full Weekend

Saturday's induction day for freshman wrestlers and gymnasts with both teams scheduled to get its first taste of inter-school competition.

The matmen will face visiting Clark Junior College of Vancouver Washington at 1 p.m. in the wrestling room of the men's PE department while the gymnasts host Cottage Grove and Sheldon High Schools at 9 a.m. in McArthur Court.

Frosh basketballers, with four games under their belt, will be active that evening, taking on the Oregon Medical and Dental Schools in a game immediately preceding the Oregon-Washington State varsity contest.

The Frosh will also play Friday night—against Lower Columbia Junior College of Washington. Both games are set for 6 p.m.

The freshman wrestling team is a little different than in previous years. Coaches used to have difficulty in filling all the weights, but now there is actually competition in several of the divisions for the top spot.

Hoiness Coaches

Coach Art Keith is "real pleased" about this. But he's on a tour of Washington and Oregon with the varsity and won't be able to watch his youngsters.

Assistant mentor Don Hoiness, a former state collegiate champion from Oregon and back from three years service with the Marines in Japan and Viet Nam, has taken over the coaching details.

Scheduled to compete this weekend are Terry Hielman (North Eugene) at 123, John West (Reedsport) at 130, Dave Baronti (South Eugene) at 137, Larry Bottoms (Oakridge) at 145, Rande Franke (Gervais) at 152, Barney Zehleisger (Medford) at 160, Dick Bellock (North Salem) at 167, Mike Stowe (North Bend) at 177, and Nick Shur (La Grande) at heavyweight.

"We could be in better shape, and we'll have to work more on takedowns; but this group has talent and a lot of spirit. We should do well," said Hoiness.

The gymnasts also have a prom-

ising group but, according to coach Dick Smith, "looks sloppy and need a lot of work."

The most outstanding individual so far appears to be Wayne Nooker of San Jose, California, who will compete in the all-around event. The other all-around man, Bob Leech from South Eugene, also, according to Smith, "looks good."

The team is fairly thin in other areas. Spence Kissler (South Eugene) will compete on the high bar and long horse, while Dennis Scholdizer (South Salem) and Roger Cook (Thurston) will add strength on the still rings.

Coach Jerry Anderson's freshman hoopster's currently sport a 2-2 record but have not seen action since before Christmas.

Four players, notes Anderson, have been playing very well. Rick Abramson from McMinnville, the team's leading scorer, is a definite varsity prospect, as is Jim Hannon (Portland), who has been "real aggressive" on the boards. Claxton Welch (David Douglas) and Glen Campbell (Thurston) also were singled out.

As far as the team is concerned, the big game of the season is next Friday when it meets the Oregon State Beavers at Corvallis. "If we lose all our other games, but beat Oregon State, we've had a satisfactory season," smiled Anderson.

Future varsity players? "We've got at least two," he said. "Abramson and Hannon. If they keep up like they've been doing, they could make it next year."

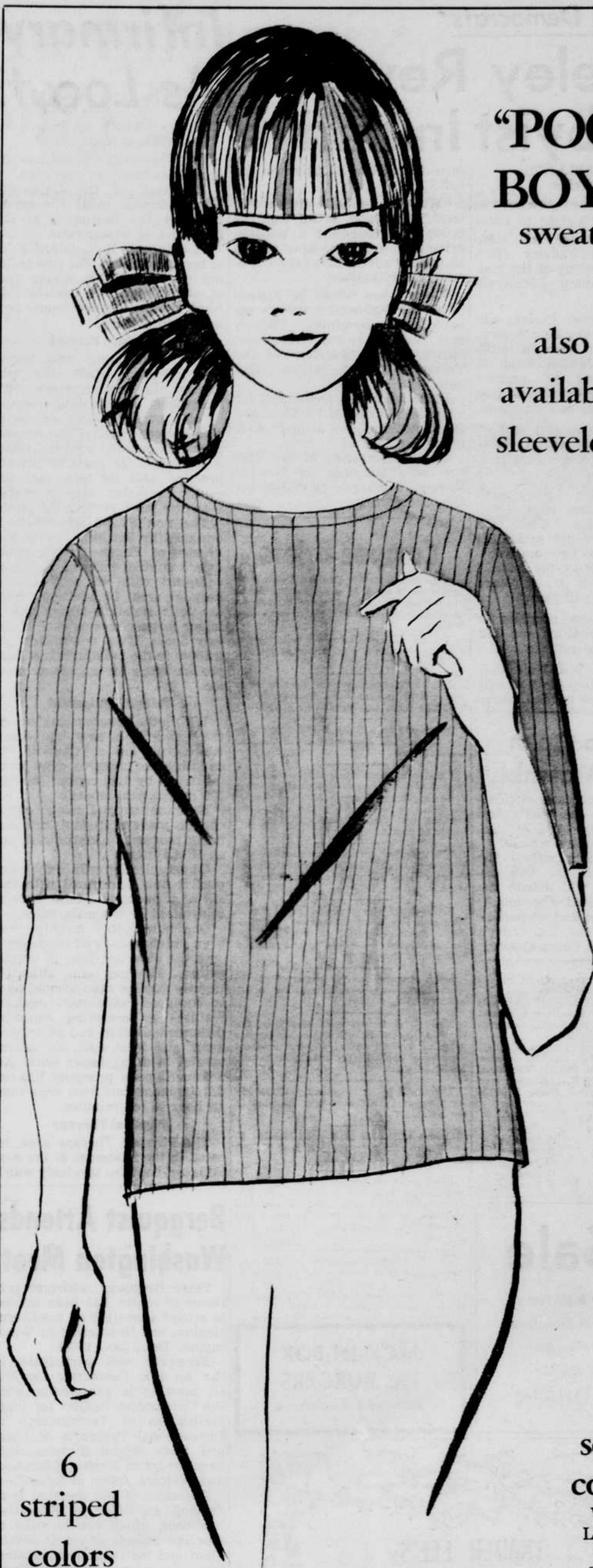
