# Sterling Excellent Present for Bride

Sterling silver was at one time the traditional present of the bride's family to the newly wedded company. Today, however, most brides choose their own silver.

The sterling is usually picked out a few months prior to the wedding. At this time the pattern is registered with the store along with the bride and groom's name and a record of pieces purchased for them. This makes it convenient for friends and relatives to add to the set as they wish.

The trends in sterling tend toward the heavy, traditional patterns. Modern designs are popular but girls generally admire the elegance of patterns similar to that of their mothers and grandmothers.

A basic silver service is a four-place setting and a service setting. It is customary now, however, to give an eight-piece setting. A setting includes a knife, fork, spoon, and salad fork. A butter knife and soup spoon are considered extra. A service setting includes basically, a ladle, two tablespoons, a sugar spoon, and butter knife. Extras include a pie server, soup, gravy ladels.

Quality in silver is fairly standardized by most silversmiths. Companies do not vary as to the content of their silver.
