

Three Top B-Ball Statistics

Two hard-hitting juniors, Dennis Baldrige and Ron Delplanche, and a vastly improved senior, Dale Ehler, led the Oregon Duck baseball statistics for 1966.

Baldrige batted a cool .382 to lead the Ducks in the hitting department, but was closely followed by Delplanche and Ehler, who both swung for a .349 average.

These three led the hitting sta-

tistics in almost all departments except home runs, where Scott Cress was third with five.

Delplanche led the Webfoots in home runs, triples, and bases on balls, while Ehler was setting a new school record by driving in 39 runs. All three of the leaders cracked out seven doubles to lead the team in that category.

Ehler's performance was a bonus to Webfoot coach Don Kirsch this spring, since the clutch-

hitting catcher hit only .286 last year with 14 rbi's.

The sophomore Cress led the team in stolen bases, swiping 10 for the season to Delplanche's eight.

In the pitching department, Joe Kniser's 2.07 ERA proved tops, while Kniser and sophomore Mike Nicksic each notched four victories.

Senior Ken Hadden led the statistics in innings pitched, 64 2/3, strikeouts, 46, and bases on balls, 26. Hadden's four defeats also led the Ducks in that department.

Heusner Slated For Institute

William Heusner, former Olympic swimmer and one of America's outstanding college coaches, will be the featured guest lecturer at 8:30 a.m. Saturday at the University's third annual Swimming Institute.

The institute is designed especially for coaches, teachers, and swimmers. During the day-long session, the program will cover stroke mechanics, conditions, and competition.

Heusner, formerly swim coach at the University of Minnesota, will present a series of lectures and demonstrations for teaching and for competitive swimming.

Registration fees of \$3 for adults and \$2 for students will be charged for the Saturday Institute, with registration opening at 8 a.m.
