

'Should Get Trounced'

Harriers Race Saturday

Oregon's cross-country team opens its dual meet season Saturday against a squad Duck coach Bill Bowerman expects will "trounce" them—the Vancouver Athletic Club.

The Vancouver runners, besides being more mature, have been in training longer than the Webfoots, Bowerman said.

"This, when taken into consideration with their quality, is just too much to overcome."

One of their runners, he said, is Don Whiten, fourth in the NCAA cross-country championships last year. Another is Jim Freeman, Western Canadian 6-

mile champion. The race will be divided into two divisions, however, the seniors and the juniors (everyone under the age of 20).

And Bowerman, with such entrants as freshman standouts Terry Dooley (last year's Canadian prep mile champ) and Gary Lindberg (1966 Washington prep mile champ) and sophomores Roscoe Divine (a sub-four minute miler) and Hal Jackson, expects to win the latter division.

The race is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. on McKenzie View Drive east of Eugene if the weather is favorable, Hendricks Park if not.
