based: the right of selection of those whom, we think, will best fit into the fraternity, both at chapter and national level.

In doing this, you ask us to reduce our fraternity into nothing more than an "eating group" or co-op as they are called on this campus. To ask us to do this is to ask us to give up that which we love and cherish. These are great requests, and ones with which most Greeks cannot comply.

How very unfortunate it is that a few people, mostly non-Greeks, seek so fervently any channel that will destroy a system that has done such great good for many thousands of young men and women for so long a time.

How unfortunate it is that these same people do not realize the tremendous efforts that are being made by our fraternity and many others in order to resolve the problems of racial discrimination within Greek life.

How easy it is for these people to sit on the sidelines and criticize the bad, never looking for the good. Perhaps that is why they are not Greeks.
