

Census Forms Need Students' Quick Reply

The big problem area in the current Lane County Census program is now the Eugene-Springfield area, census officials reported recently.

Census forms were mailed out to all residents of this area, and 81 per cent have been returned. This means that an estimated 8,000 forms are still out, Census Director Alan Mohr reported.

The census office emphasized that it is not too late to mail the forms in, and added that 100 a day are still being received.

Mohr pointed out that returns have not been up to expectation from University students living in private housing. Many out-of-state and foreign students apparently feel they do not need to return the forms. All of these students should complete and mail in the forms at once. Students in dormitories, fraternities and married student housing have been counted.

"Time is running out, and we must file our report with the state by December 10," Mohr said.

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
