

Faculty Members Publish Books

Two University faculty members, Charles E. Johnson and Francis J. Reithel, have recently published books which are expected to become widely used college texts.

"Accounting" by Johnson and two other college professors, and "Concepts in Biochemistry" by Reithel, were released last month by McGraw-Hill Book Company.

Johnson's book, the first in a three-volume series in accounting, is a second edition of a book first published in 1962 which has become one of the major college accounting textbooks.

A professor of accounting and Dean of the College of Liberal Arts at Oregon, Johnson wrote the 900-page text along with Walter Meigs of the University of Southern California.

Dr. Reithel's book, "Concepts of Biochemistry," is distinguished by a number of unique features, including photographs of three-dimensional models and bibliographies appended to each section.

Four University faculty members, who have taught at the University for a combined total of 141 years, have announced plans to retire this spring.

They are George Hopkins, professor of music; Miss Janet G. Woodruff, professor of physical education; Miss Brownell Frasier, associate professor of interior design, School of Architecture and Allied Arts; and Mrs. Emma S. Wright, senior acquisitions librarian.

Hopkins has been at the School of Music since its beginning 46 years ago, and Miss Woodruff has been associated with the department of physical education for women for 38 years.

Miss Frasier has guided the development of interior design curriculum for nearly 40 years, making her program nationally known.

Mrs. Wright came to the University as a reference librarian in 1946.

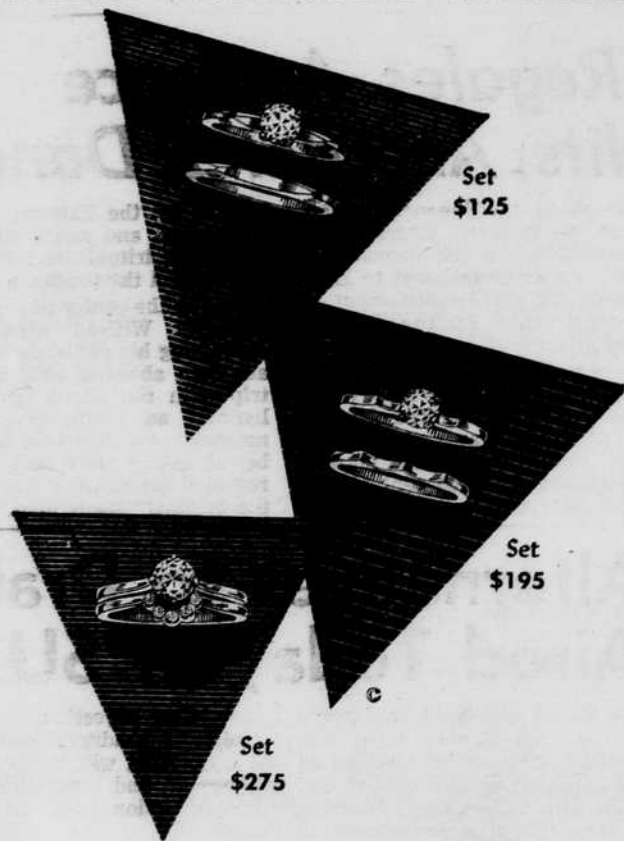
