Booters Await Tourney

 Oregon Soccer Club's Duck and Mallard teams will step out of the league competition this weekend to participate in the Washington State University Invitational Tournament. The club will field one combined squad in the eight-team affair which begins Friday at Pullman.
 Oregon's first opponent will be Washington State "B" team in a quarterfinal game at 8 p.m. Friday. The second WSU team became an unexpected tournament entry when Oregon State withdrew from the field.
 Earlier quarterfinal rounds Friday pair Washington State "A" and Gonzaga, Washington and Idaho State, and Montana and Idaho.
 Although it is the weakest

team, Webfoot coach Hans Buhrmann will not overlook WSU "B" as a contender. But he expects Gonzaga and Washington to be the main threats to Oregon's championship hopes.
 If the Ducks win Friday night's encounter, they will advance to the semifinal round at 3 p.m. Saturday against the winner of the Idaho-Montana game. The winner of this match will have a brief three-hour rest before the 8 p.m. championship game.
 Oregon's knowledge of its possible opponents is very limited, with last spring's 9-1 win over WSU at Eugene the only previous competition against any of the tournament teams.
 The 18-man traveling squad will leave Eugene by bus Thursday noon and return Sunday.

Ducks making the trip include Vernon Crew, goalie; Henk Menkveld and Buhrmann, fullbacks; Bob Kerr, Harold McKnight, Tony Evans and Harry Deboer, halfbacks; Tony Owens, Hans Niks, Paul Wormleighton, Andrew Nkongho, Ian Stevenson and Paul Chelidi, forwards.
 Mallards making the trip include Randy Swangard, Joe Macca, Graham Mason, Norm Pressey and Cees Van Der Waerden.
