The ASU Senate will meet at 7:30 this evening to clarify its thinking on the issues it will take up with the Faculty-Senate in their joint meeting Wednesday.

The theme of the meeting was set by a five-page guideline sheet distributed to the senators at their last meeting.

The guideline says, among other things, "While some functions, such as the assignments of grades, must be the responsibility of individual faculty members, students ought to participate with the faculty in setting general policy concerning grading systems and procedures, and scholastic sanctions."

**Sabotage Clues To Net Reward**

**EUGENE (P)** — State Sen. Ed Fadeley, D-Eugene, says he will put his money behind his beliefs by offering a \$500 reward for information in connection with the sabotage of the Naval Reserve Center in Eugene.

Fadeley, who is the Democratic candidate for Congress from the Fourth District, said his reward offer should be matched by \$500 from the Naval Reserve Division, \$200 from the Marine Reserve, \$200 from the Naval Construction Battalion Seabees and \$100 from the Naval Reserve Officer's School.

Fadeley said he is concerned over the rage of destructive violence in the country.

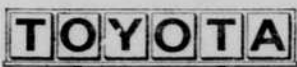
