ROTC protest slated

The new ROTC headquarters on Alder St. will be condemned Wednesday.

The condemnation, to come as the conclusion of a march "against this increasing war in Indochina," will be for "war crimes" instead of unsafe conditions in the building.

The march from the EMU to the ROTC building will begin at the EMU at noon. But the march will not be a normal protest march—it will include floats and a marching band. According to leaflets, the "People's Marching Band" will be making its grand debut and everybody is invited to bring instruments. Also on hand will be floats and a chalk-in."

Department gets grant

The University mathematics department has received a \$12,110 grant from the National Science Foundation to support a summer undergraduate research participation program.

At least ten undergraduate students from the University and other colleges and universities will conduct research projects for 10 weeks supervised by faculty members. Stipends of \$60 per week will be given to the researchers, plus tuition and fees payment and travel expenses in some instances.

The program, which begins June 21, will be directed by Andrew Moursund, professor of mathematics. Richard Koch, associate professor of mathematics will also be involved in the program.

Any error that appears on the printout should be reported to the Office of the Registrar immediately to avoid any kind of misunderstanding concerning class registration and grade options.

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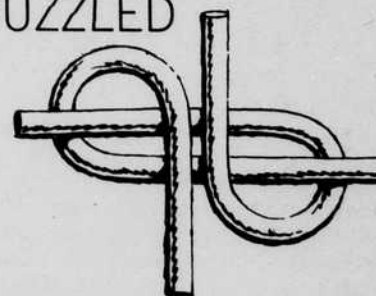
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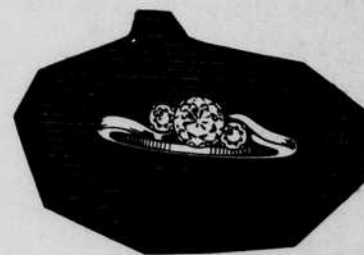
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
