- 1961 50,000 letters opposing national bomb-shelter was successful
- 1964 50,000 letters defeated federal gun control legislation following President Kennedy's assassination
- 1970 50,000 letters in a write-in campaign by the Sierra Club succeeded in national park legislation
- 1971 50,000 letters contributed to the defeat of the SST

- ★ every write-in campaign by 50,000 voters has been successful
- ★ there are 8 million students that are now voters
- ★ this will be the largest write-in campaign by voters in history
- ★ Nixon won election by 500,000 votes
