Student to present piano recital

The recital is part of Miss Woo's work toward a Bachelor of Music degree.

There is no admission charge for the program.

Tickets for the cooking program are \$2.50. They can be obtained by mail from the University Museum of Art.

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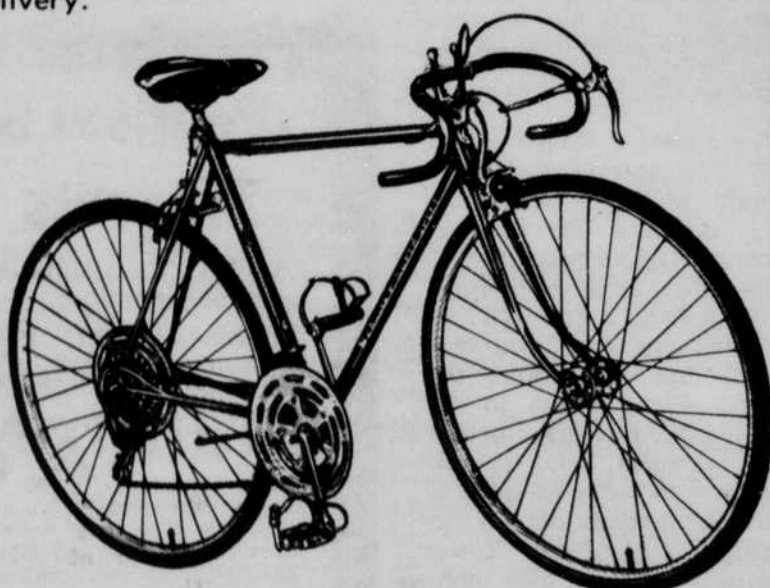
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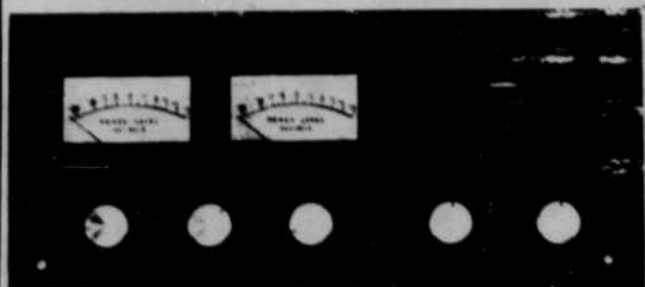
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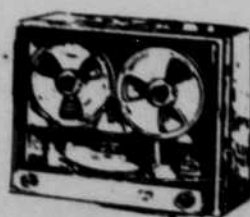
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
