

## SECOND FLOOR

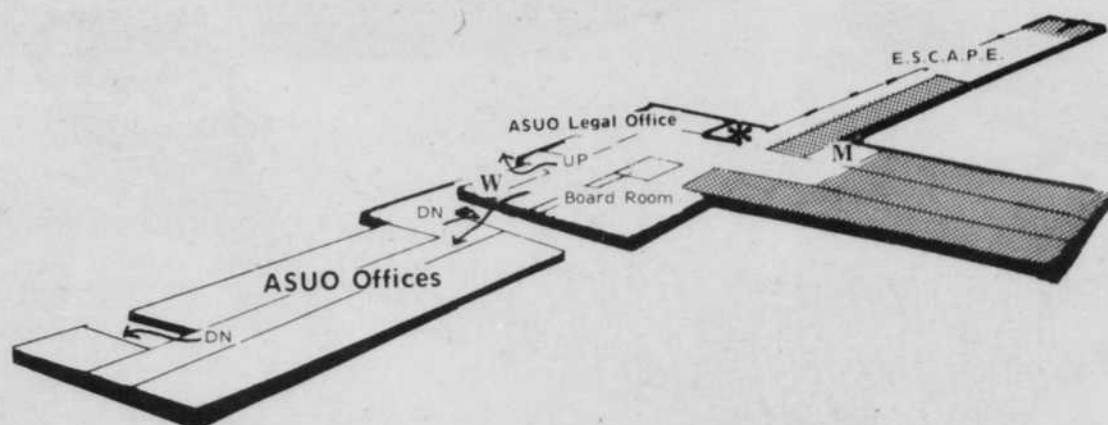
Scene of frequent movies, dances concerts and meetings is the EMU Ballroom on the second floor. It can be reached by either the main stairway or the elevator from the main floor.
