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Pro-tem director for Ethnic Studies?

The knotty problem of whether or not to appoint an interim director for the Ethnic Studies Program in the absence of qualified candidates was discussed at an Ethnic Studies Committee meeting Tuesday.

A discussion of responsibility ensued. Committee members decided they did not have authority to recommend an interim director and agreed to send the issue back to the ethnic studies search committee.

"This means we're not ac-

cepting the buck," said chairer Paul Simonds. "We'll leave the burden of making that choice to the search committee."

He said the Ethnic Studies "buck" is the problem of how to reconcile administration pressure that the \$35,000 program, already a year in formation, begin now, and minority pressure that more candidates be sought for director.

An interim directorship would allow the search committee to contact more candidates, especially from minorities. There are three candidates now under consideration from a field of 10.

Ethnic Studies Committee member Maxine Zinn felt the current field did not tap the job market of minorities.

"My feeling is that we should start the whole search again," she said. "I know a number of groups on campus who are dissatisfied with the present selections, and who will be very vocal if there are not more."

She noted that a recent plan, for a \$3,500 raise in the yearly salary of the director (from \$15,000 to \$18,500) should attract more qualified candidates.

Simonds, however, thought the field was "not that bad."

"All of those under consideration now would make quite adequate candidates," he said.

The search committee for ethnic studies will meet Thursday.

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Deferment change announced

Col. Lake Bellinger, chief of local board operations for Oregon State Selective Service Headquarters, announced Tuesday that those men with II-S student deferments will be placed in the second priority of deliverable men and will be reclassified by the local draft boards.

Bellinger recommended that those people with a II-S classification take no initiative in contacting their local boards and wait for their reclassification.

State headquarters has received no detailed instructions as of yet.

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
