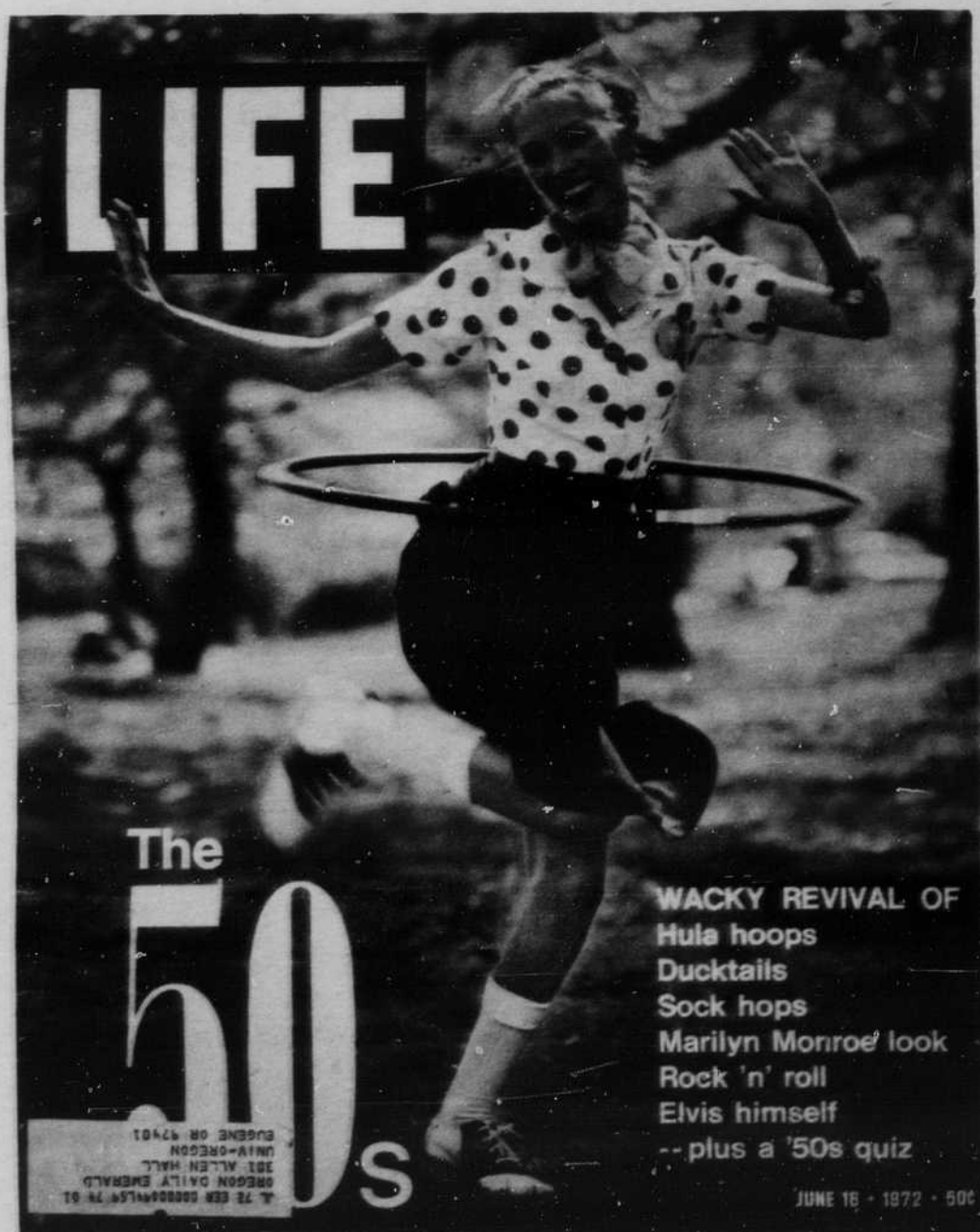


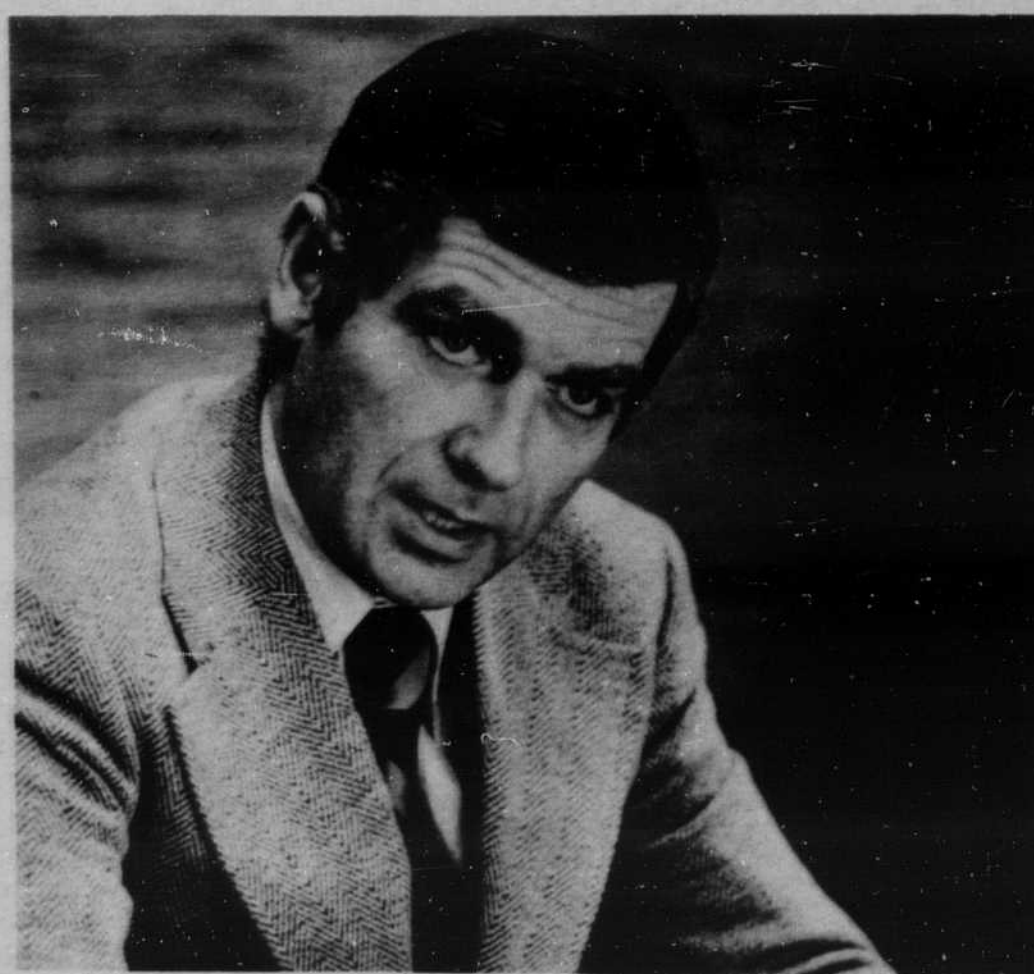
Lance Loud Family of the Year
