tonight in the cafeteria of Lincoln School, 13th and Jefferson. A donation of one dollar is asked.

"We also plan to hold pancake breakfasts on Thursday mornings at Mama's Home Fried Truck Stop," Zagorin continued. "This fund-raising idea should materialize in a few weeks."

Numerous educational field trips are on the agenda for Children's Community School.

"Already we've visited Marcola Free School on the coast, and we started the year with a campout at Fall Creek," she said.

Projects planned for the school year include a juvenile justice study, a math resource center, and poetry readings.

In a cooperative program with nearby Lincoln School, the two share an annex behind Lincoln.

"Children's Community School uses it for woodworking, crafts, and cooking," Zagorin said. "We also share Lincoln's library and hope to have access to its gym."

"Most children are enrolled here because of parental objections to the public school system," she remarked. "The parents object to the system as they knew it in the past, or because of direct experiences in the present."

Different from schools of the past, Children's Community School's emphasis is placed on counter-sexism and counter-racism.

"This is accomplished by having as much role reversal as possible and by avoiding sexist and racist literature," Zagorin said.

The school staff relates to the child as a "whole person" and urges expression of emotions.

"Fights and disciplinary problems are worked out here by talking, and safe ways to express hostility or anger are given," she added.

The children at the school are given encouragement each step of the way "to improve their self concepts," Zagorin said.
