Victor Perlo on Watergate

(Continued from Page 3)

Perlo outlined a set of policies which he feels are essential to achieving greater social justice in America, including price rollbacks on essential consumer goods to August 1971 levels; universal wage increases of \$1 per hour; a restructuring of the tax system requiring more taxation of corporate wealth and wealthy private individuals; outlawing of racism with criminal prosecution against violators; increased employment of minorities at all levels in proportion to their numbers in the population; and a radical reduction of military spending, with increased attention on social services.

Perlo also emphasized the role of political activism in restructuring America. He said that the "campaign against
