

Applications are being accepted for candidates for the Rotary Foundation educational awards for study abroad in 1975 76, the Rotary Club of Eugene has announced. The deadline is March 15.

The Foundation offers four types of awards: Graduate fellowships for students 20-28 years old; undergraduate scholarships for students with a minimum of two years of university level work and who are 18-24 years old; technical training awards for those with a secondary education and at least two years of work experience who are 21-35 years old; awards to teachers of the handicapped for those who have been engaged as full time teachers of the mentally, physically or educationally handicapped for at least two years at the time of application and are 25-50 years old.

Each award includes round-trip transportation, educational and living expenses for one academic year and funds for intensive language training if necessary.

Further information about the awards is available from any member of the Rotary Club of Eugene.
