And do it intelligently. It's a long voters' guide we know. But we would like you to look at as many of the stories as you can in order to familiarize yourself with what the candidates stand for.

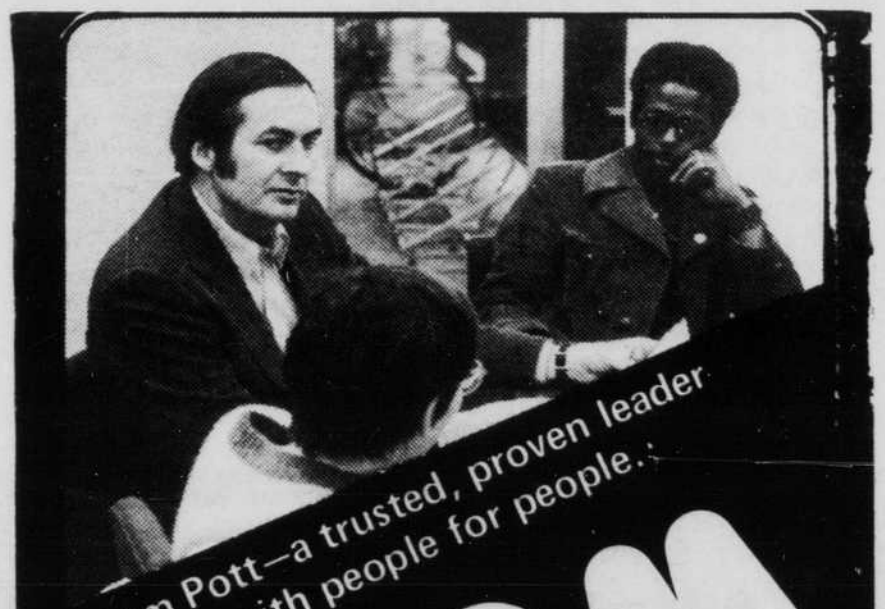
We know you are interested in the famous people running for office. But we urge you to look at the "minor" candidates also.
