Hartshorne shines in 2nd scrimmage

Oregon's basketball team moved a step closer to replacing the void left by center Gerald Willett, and although the job is far from done, Coach Dick Harter is smiling at the prospects.

Six-foot-nine freshman Dan Hartshorne pumped in 16 points Tuesday night in a losing cause, but began to look more like a fixture than anyone else vying for the spot, as the Green team edged the White team 68-63 in the team's second intrasquad scrimmage at Portland's Sunset High School.

Hartshorne, the Los Angeles recruit, stirred the whites at the beginning of the second half and brought them back from a 36-26 halftime deficit to one point behind with a half-minute to go.

Ernie Kent and Mark Barwig paced the Green unit in the backcourt, hitting a combined 14 of 22 from the floor to build the halftime lead. Greg Ballard was

the dominant force on the boards with 13 rebounds.

The white team, beset by poor shooting and a rash of turnovers, also had to contend with 14 points from the big forward.

The first home scrimmage will be held next Tuesday at 7:30 in Mac Court.
