

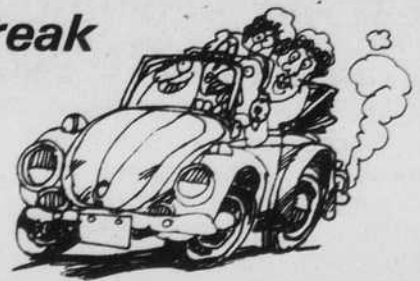

Candidates Radio series to allow listeners to question presidential candidates

Members of Oregon Common Cause will participate in the newly-created National Public Radio Network series beginning Thursday, according to Chuck Hale, Eugene co-ordinator for Oregon Common Cause.

The series, "Candidates on the Line," features one presidential candidate per show. Listening audiences throughout the country will be able to participate in questioning the candidates by calling a toll-free number several hours prior to air time.

"This is a pioneer effort in unrehearsed communication between citizens and presidential candidates," says Hale. "We hope citizens across the country will take advantage of this unique opportunity to ask candidates questions of concern to them."

The local involvement by Common Cause is part of its nationwide program during the 1976 election year to bring about greater dialogue between candidates and citizens, and to permit a full discussion of issues of concern. Also participating in the radio series are the League of Women Voters, the American Bar Association, the National Council of Senior Citizens and the AFL-CIO.

Eugene AM radio station KOAC will broadcast the 90 minute programs beginning with the Thursday segment and running through March. The schedule is as follows:

Interviews will also be scheduled with George Wallace, Ronald Reagan and Pres. Ford.
