Nazi-hunter to end work

VIENNA, Austria (AP) — Nazi-hunter Simon Wiesenthal said Wednesday he will end his search for hidden war criminals in the next year or so and will devote much of the intervening time to cases of alleged Nazi offenders now living in the United States.

"I am 67 years old. The men who were in responsible positions in the Nazi era are now 75 years or older, only the relative small-fry are around 50," he said in an interview. He added he would continue his work as usual through 1976.

"A high official of the American attorney general's office will come to see me on Jan. 14," Wiesenthal said, withholding the official's name.

He added, "There are some 70 cases of Nazi collaborators in the United States, who were not Germans, though. They were Hungarians, Romanians, Slovaks and Baltics." He said documents showed that these people were involved in war crimes and their discovery might result in the loss of their American citizenships.

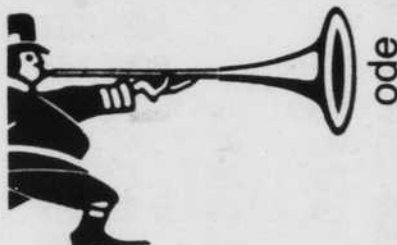
In Washington, a Justice Department spokesman said he could find no one who knew of the planned meeting with Wiesenthal, although he added it was possible that Wiesenthal had arranged to meet with a department official based overseas.
