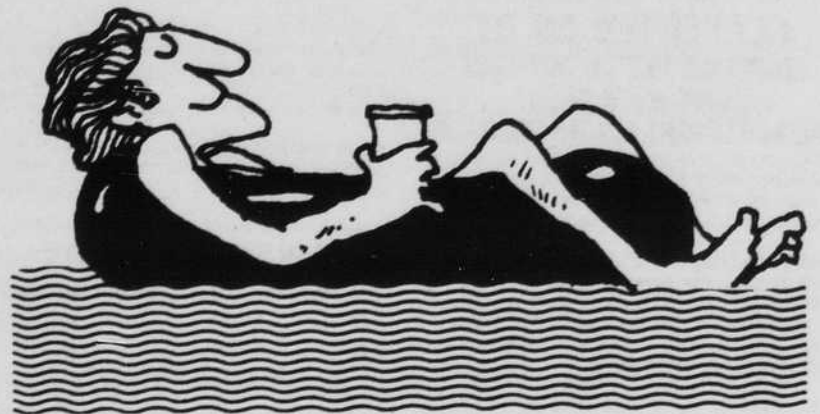




MARVIN W. FRENCOPPER SELLS OUT AND RETIRES IN ELKTON OREGON.

Read a vet as Vermeil leaves Pac-8

(AP) — Don Read, though only in his third year as Oregon's football coach, must now be considered a veteran of the Pacific-8 conference.

It was announced Sunday that UCLA Coach Dick Vermeil had been named head football coach for the Philadelphia Eagles.

Vermeil became the fourth Pac-8 football coach to resign since November. The others are John McKay, Southern Cal; Dee Andros, Oregon State and Jim Sweeney, Washington State.

Vermeil's move means that Read has now been in

the league longer than anyone except California's Mike White and Stanford's Jack Christiansen, both of whom joined the league in 1972.

Vermeil is being given complete charge of the Eagles' football operation with authority to make trades, direct the draft and sign players.

The selection of Vermeil ended an embarrassing search for a successor to Mike McCormack, who coached the Eagles to a 16-25-1 record.

Vermeil earned national recognition this past season when UCLA went 9-2-1, won the Pac-8 championship, and whipped previously unbeaten and then top-ranked Ohio State 23-10 in the Rose Bowl.
