

DA position attracts senator

Democratic State Senator Betty Browne says that morale in the Lane County District Attorney's office is "extremely poor."

Browne, an attorney, presently holds the senate seat for District 22, which includes all of Lane County, except for Eugene-Springfield, and the northern part of Douglas County.

District Attorney Pat Horton received a barrage of criticism from Browne Monday in a discussion at the University, particularly for office spending, poor record of victories in homicide cases, and his alleged spending of state money for personal gain.

She says she will make the spending for personal gain an issue in the campaign, because "the use he has made of taxpayers' money to generate his own income is unethical. I think that kind of thing is wrong."

According to Browne, the budget for the office last year was

\$750,000, and Horton is asking for a 60 per cent increase for the coming year. She cited his spending for personal use and the "extravagance" of having seven investigators in the office as reasons for the large increase in costs.

Another of Browne's criticisms of Horton is that "he has been out

of the office so much he's not on top of the cases."

One of the problems confronting the DA's office at present is a high turnover rate. Browne says "one of the things Horton promised was to stop the turnover in the office. But the turnover problem has never been worse."

Browne, who says she is going to put an "all-out effort into the primary race," said that one of the problems she expects to encounter in her campaign is a lack of knowledge of the functions of the office. She feels one important part of her campaign is to "explain what the job is."

She believes one change she would make if elected is to have "career prosecutors in the office — somebody who will stay with the office."

Browne also spoke against the death penalty and added she is opposed to gun control because it is not "realistic." She favors mandatory sentences and tighter parole regulations.

1990 Plan anticipates update
